2026 CSA Agreement

Thanks for your interest in a CSA share from West End Farm! This agreement represents our mutual commitment: we'll work hard to provide you with the freshest, highest-quality local produce possible, and you'll commit to supporting the farm through the growing season. Our goal is to help you enjoy fresh, healthy food while strengthening our local food system.

THE CSA FARM

"CSA" stands for *Community Supported Agriculture*. It's a partnership between a local farm and the community. Members purchase a share of the harvest at the beginning of the season, which provides the farm with essential up-front funds for seeds and supplies. In return, members receive a box of freshly harvested, seasonal produce each week throughout the season.

Participation in a CSA is also an educational experience. You'll learn about Nebraska seasonality: greens and radishes in spring, tomatoes and melons in summer, and root crops in fall. At West End Farm, we grow over 40 different vegetables, herbs, and melons to offer you variety throughout the season. You'll also receive weekly emails with recipes, storage tips, and farm updates to help you use your produce.

RISK & REWARD

Community Supported Agriculture involves shared risks and benefits. Farming is inherently unpredictable: hail, drought, insects, and other external conditions can lead to crop failure. By purchasing a CSA share, you are agreeing to share those risks with us. There is a chance that certain crops will fail and that some weeks your box will not be as full as other weeks. And while unlikely, a disaster could result in little or no produce for the year. However, you are also sharing in the benefits of bountiful harvests. In good years, your weekly boxes will be filled with produce of exceptional quality. CSA members also have the first chance to order any additional produce available.

THE SHARE

Small share: 5-6 items each week of the most popular garden vegetables. This is a great option for 1-2 person households, families who eat out a lot, or people who want to supplement their home garden.

Large share: 7-8 items each week (some in larger quantities than the small share), with a few additional interesting vegetables (leeks, squash blossoms, okra, etc). This is a good size for families or those who enjoy cooking and preserving.

The main (summer) harvest season will be 20 weeks long, from approximately early June to mid-October. You'll receive a box of produce every week during the season. Due to the seasonal nature of farming, your first couple of boxes may contain fewer items, while boxes in midsummer may contain more. Here are examples of what you might expect in a small share box at three different times throughout the season:

- June: a bag of peas, one head of lettuce, one head of broccoli, one bunch of rhubarb, and one bunch of green onions.
- August: two sweet onions, a quart box of tomatoes, two bell peppers, a quart box of potatoes, a bag of green beans, and two cucumbers.
- October: two pounds of sweet potatoes, a butternut squash, one bunch of carrots, two bulbs of garlic, and one bunch of radishes.

At each pickup site, you'll find a "swap box" with a few extras. If there's something in your box you don't

want, leave it in the swap box and choose another item instead. You can also donate items to the swap box for others to enjoy. (Swap box not available for delivery shares.)

In the event of unforeseen circumstances, West End Farm reserves the right to skip a week's share delivery and add an additional week to the end of the season instead.

SPRING AND FALL SHARES

Spring and fall shares are optional four-week add-ons before and after the main summer season. This is a single-size share with about 6 items per box. Spring boxes contain items like asparagus, radishes, and lettuce, and fall boxes contain storage crops, late summer crops, and some salad greens. You can sign up for one or both seasons, as available.

EGGS

As an optional addition to your weekly box of produce, you can also get a weekly small (1/2 dozen) or large (1 dozen) egg share. The size of your egg share does not need to match the size of your produce share. Quantities are limited, and CSA members have first priority. The eggs are from Jano Farms' free-range hens you see running around at West End Farm. You'll pick up your eggs at the same time you get your produce box.

PICK UP

Community is an important aspect of the CSA model, and you have the chance to build community with your fellow CSA subscribers at the pick-up site each week. Upon signing up for a CSA share, you will select your pick-up location from the following options:

- West End Farm (Plymouth) Mondays, 4:00–6:30 p.m.
- Beatrice Farmers Market (Beatrice) Thursdays, 4:00–6:30 p.m.
- College View Farmers Market (Lincoln) Sundays, 10:00 a.m.–2:00 p.m.
- Beatrice Home/Office Delivery Tuesdays, 7:00–8:00 a.m. (Please confirm availability for your area before signing up.)

If you are unable to pick up your box, please send a friend or neighbor to pick it up or make other arrangements with the farm in advance. If your box is not picked up during the scheduled time and no advance arrangements have been made, your box will be donated or used elsewhere.

Please return your empty box the following week or bring your own container to transfer your produce.

PAYMENT

The early bird sign up period (with discount) for 2025 CSA members runs from Nov 4 - Nov 14, 2025. CSA sign up will open to all others on November 15. Everyone who signs up prior to the end of 2025 can pay in full or reserve a share with a \$100 deposit (balance will be invoiced in 2026, due on April 1st). Shares purchased in 2026 will require full payment at time of purchase. CSA shares are nonrefundable.

You can pay online with a credit card at our website: <u>westendfarmne.com/csa</u>. Or, fill out an online sign-up form or print a paper form and then mail a check or deliver cash to **West End Farm LLC**.

COMMUNICATION

Good communication is important to address any questions you may have regarding the CSA. It's also important for the farm to be able to contact you in the event of a change in procedure. The email address you provide during the registration process will be added to West End Farm's email list. You will receive weekly emails during the growing season with farm announcements, a list of items in that week's box, and a recipe. Please read these emails, and make sure that emails from "westendfarmne@gmail.com" are not routing to your spam folder. Email is our primary method of communicating with you in the event of an emergency or inclement weather that could change the pick up location or schedule. You can best reach the farm via email or phone. Please reach out with any questions you have.
