Boston, MA

<u>Boston University</u> - Summer on-campus housing to college students who have internships or supervised research in the Greater Boston Area. Rates range from \$343-\$504/week.

Our Home Boston - Short-term homestays in the Boston area. Application fee applies; Monthly rates from \$900 - \$1500/ month

<u>Suffolk University</u> - Summer housing for college students from all over the world with summer internships in the downtown Boston area.
