Officials - no update

**Registrar** – Melissa emailed the latest coach and officials' credentials reports on 5/10/25.

Athlete Awards are problematic in process and the way they are granted. Usually ordered by end of long course. Senior scholarships is fine, but athlete awards is a self selection bias. It goes to those who apply themselves and the parents who actively get everything together to submit. Winners each year are deserving but we are missing a lot of kids. Points are also not weighted properly with power points. Suggestion has been to nominate by coach nominations, but some coaches won't nominate.

Brett shared he feels power points do make sense, but it is hard to explain to parents. It might serve well as a cut to determine top 10 and then encourage those to apply. Suggestion to make the coach portion more of a survey versus a letter. The essay portion is also very subjective. Suggestion to have athlete resume instead. Perhaps athletes could have choice between writing an essay or recording a short video to address the prompts.

Melissa would like a committee to form in June to discuss all these suggestions. Brianna is interested in serving on this committee, as well as Heather.

**Coaches** – Coach reps will be encouraged to send out reminders about coaches' training and maintaining required credentials.

**Open Forum** – (from beginning of meeting) Reps from Center Against Sexual and Family Violence shared resources available in our community. They are seeking donations of swimwear and gear to equip their children groups so they can go to water parks.

The City reached out about safe sport swimming and Brett referred them to Todd for in-water trainings.

With budget for low income swimmer support- there are 22 kids in Upward Bound. Sharks would like to provide them the opportunity to be part of a competitive team. Would Border
