



# Troop 101

## Community Service Record

A major component of the Scouting program and particularly Troop 101 is Community Service. Second Class, Star Rank and Life Rank all require varying degrees of Community Service. To earn credit for these ranks all Scouts must participate in Troop sponsored Community Service events. It is Troop 101's policy that Non-Troop Events can not account for more than 50% of your required time. Troop Sponsored events may however account for 100% of your required time.

If you participate in a Troop Sponsored event all you have to do is sign the attendance sheet. If you are participating in an event outside the Troop you **MUST** 1) Bring this form to a Troop Meeting **PRIOR** to the event and have the Scoutmaster or an Assistant Scoutmaster pre-approve the event; 2) Bring the form to the event and have an event leader complete the date, number of hours and sign the form; and 3) Return the form at a Troop Meeting.

### Community Service Advancement Requirements

#### Second Class

Participate in an approved (minimum of one hour) service project. Either Troop or Non-Troop service is okay.

#### Star Rank

While a First Class Scout, take part in service projects totaling at least 6 hours of work. At least 3 hours **MUST** be in Troop 101 Community Service Events.

#### Life Rank

While a Star Scout, take part in service projects totaling at least 6 hours of work. At least 3 hours **MUST** be in Troop 101 Community Service Events.

*Note: Merit Badge/OA/or other BSA related service hours cannot be used for Advancement.*
