Assignment: The student will create 5 Glow Portraits Pictures using Photoshop. The photos will be 4" x 6" in size (300 resolution). Photos need to have Outer Glow Effect applied to them. The student's work will be turned in via the teacher's folder on the S Drive in the following manner: S:\Commstud\Photo\Student Work\Teacher\Assignment folder.

Purpose: The students will learn how to create an original piece of work in the computer program Photoshop, following the Glow Portrait Tutorial. 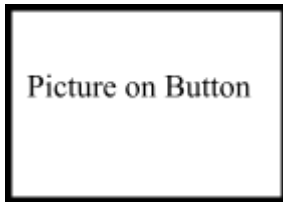
