CVU hosted the annual Vermont FIRST Tech Challenge Robotics Championship February 2023 . There were 19 robotics teams from all over Vermont and this is the second year that CVU has entered TWO teams into the tournament--the varsity squad RoboHawks and JV squad RoboRedhawks. You may recall that last year the RoboHawks qualified for the World Championship...well this year both teams were outstanding! **This year CVU will be sending not one team to the World Championship, but BOTH teams!**

A special shout out this week to our students who organized, donated, and ran our annual blood drive. We collected 63 units of blood, each with the potential to save three lives! Over half of these donations were first time donors. Thank you to everyone for supporting this event, and making it a successful day!

The Spectrum SleepOut was a huge success! Forty CVU students braved the cold and slept outside in solidarity with unhoused youth in our community. Our CVU team raised \$4,500.

**Mira Novak** competed in the state semifinals for Poetry Out Loud at the Barre Opera House. She qualified for finals! Mira will represent CVU at state finals, competing against nine other finalists from across Vermont.

In March 2023, CVU Penguin Plungers finally made it to the icy waters at Shelburne Beach in support of Special Olympics. CVU raised over \$16,000 and registered over 100 plungers. This

plunge was in response to the canceled event at the Burlington waterfront due to inclement weather. CVU found a way - promises made, promises kept!

Tamie-Jo Dickinson won FBLA Advisor of the Year and was honored in a ceremony last Friday.

CVU's Scholars Bowl team finished its 22-23 season as a semi-finalist in the State tournament playoffs, in April. CVU started as the 6th seed. CVU's Scholars Bowl has now reached the "Final Four" of the State tournament playoffs 16 times in the past 21 years, more than any other Vermont school.

most attended event of our Scholars Bowl season, this year drawing 24 teams from 3 states. CVU's varsity A team ran its record to 27-0 by winning all 7 matches and defeating runner-up Hanover to win the PHAT varsity bracket for the second consecutive season.
