CCP Release Guidelines

Logan Elm Middle School/High School

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College Credit Plus can be a great opportunity for students while in high school. Taking CCP courses can however, present scheduling challenges with the different options available to students.

There are three different options when taking CCP courses;

1. Online courses through a college
2. On-campus courses where you attend class at a local college.
3. CCP courses housed at Logan Elm taught by Logan Elm teachers.

When taking a CCP course outside that is not housed at Logan Elm, there will be a placeholder in your schedule that will say "CCP". We are implementing new guidelines at Logan Elm this year in regards to leaving campus when you have a "CCP" spot in your schedule.

General rules/guidelines for students that have CCP courses in their schedule that are not offered at Logan Elm;

1. Underclassmen are not able to be released from Logan Elm unless they are going to a physical college campus for classes.
2. Seniors are able to apply for Early Release after 6th period. If a senior has more than one CCP course in their schedule, they may also apply for Special Circumstances Early release to leave additional period(s). However, no students will be able to come and go from Logan Elm for CCP classes, unless they have a course scheduled at a physical college campus in the middle of the day.
3. All underclassmen that are taking online CCP courses will report to the CCP lab at Logan Elm during the period(s) in their schedule that say CCP. This is where you can work on your CCP courses online. This lab will have different wifi restrictions and you will be able to access what you need to complete work without restrictions.
4. Seniors taking online CCP courses will also report to the CCP lab at Logan Elm during "CCP" marked periods that fall in the middle of the day when they have Logan Elm courses before and after.
