The primary goal of the Watch DOGS program is to provide positive male role models for the students, demonstrating by their presence that education is important.

Program Benefits

- Students gain a positive male role model. Many students do not have a father-figure present in their home and these students will benefit when a positive role model is present.
- Fathers get a glimpse of their students' everyday world and learn about the increasingly complex challenges and decisions today's youth are facing. As a result, they can learn to relate better to students and hopefully connect with them.
- Fathers gain a greater awareness of the positive impact they can have on their student's life in three critical areas including: academic performance, self-esteem, social behavior.

Who are WATCH D.O.G.S. (Dads of Great Students)?

Watch DOGS are fathers, grandfathers, uncles, and other father-figures who volunteer at an official Watch DOGS school. During the day, Watch DOGS may read and work on flash cards with students, play at recess, eat lunch with students, watch the school entrances and hallways, assist with traffic flow, and any other assigned activities where they can actively engage with not only their own students, but other students as well.
