

## Delux's how to clean artifacts from digitals without affecting screentones




Then make two copies and rename them, while hiding the waifu2x clean




rename them to the task your about to do so you don't get confused always put the white level on top




we're going to level the whites off Select the white level layer




press ctrl+L move the grey slider all the way to the right




It should look like this




Then you level off all the artifacts and press "OK"



Now you must be thinking "oh great, now the image is all dark, that does fucking nothing!" That's where this bar comes into handy



This is the blend modes




Set it to lighten


and it'll take all the pixels in that layer lighter than the pixels in the bottom layer So now it looks like this




We're not done yet because we still have to level the blacks as well So select the black levels layer




press ctrl+L again move the grey slider all the way to the left




then you level off the black specs




Press "OK" when you're done




now you must be thinking, "wow it looks super fucking light, that does nothing!" Well we're back to that menu, remember?





Set it to darken this time

Not really remove, more like smooth out

because the resulting product has blurs of super light grey and super dark grey

depending on how jpeg the raws are

you can turn the most hideous artifacts



into something more pleasant



And the textures of the hair that would've been denoised



are restored back
