Gospel Discussion/Learning/Social group: This is for YSAs in Layton, Fruit Heights, Kaysville, Farmington, and Centerville that are age 25-35 years old. This group meets at a church building in Fruit Heights (901 S. Mountain Road, Fruit Heights) at 7pm on Thursdays. It is kind of like the Gospel Discussion group listed just above with classes

at 7pm and dinner after classes at 8pm. Some of the classes are more gospel related and others are life skills related but with tying the gospel into them. Classes being taught this summer are:
