<b>TITLE</b>	<b>Amending Chapter II: ASUCR Senators Increase the Number Primary Authors on Senate Bills and Resolutions</b>

**BACKGROUND**

The purpose of this senate bill is to remove redundant text from the ASUCR Bylaws and to increase the number of elected officials as primary authors that are allowed on a senate resolution. This bill comes at a crucial time as we continue efforts to encourage collaboration between ASUCR officials.

**THE ASUCR SENATE HEREBY AMENDS CHAPTER II OF THE ASUCR BYLAWS AS FOLLOWS,**

**1. Chapter 2, Section 4, Subsection L.**

(l) Submit a minimum of three (3) pieces of legislation to the Legislative Review Committee, with at least one (1) being submitted by the start of Winter Quarter the end of each academic quarter.

- i. There shall be no more than two (2) four (4) ASUCR elected officials who are primary authors per Senate Bill, and no more than three (3) four (4) ASUCR elected officials who are primary authors per Senate Resolution. There shall be no limit on the number of primary authors who are not ASUCR elected officials.
- ii. Only Senators who are primary authors on legislation shall satisfy their legislative requirement.
