

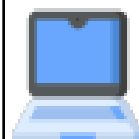

<p>Incoming Grade 8 TDSB students are eligible to register for the Continuing Education Reach Ahead GLD201 course.</p> <p>In Person Learning - Students will be with a teacher face-to-face.</p> <p>Remote Learning - Students will be with a teacher live synchronously daily online. Students need to log-in to Brightspace every day</p> <p>In both programs students will be with their teacher - Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Attendance is MANDATORY</p> <p>Successfully completion of this course counts towards the OSSD.</p>	<p>Incoming Grade 8 students are eligible to register for the e-Summer Reach Ahead GLD20E course</p> <p>The e-Summer Program is entirely delivered asynchronously online. The teacher will deliver a live lesson each day for about an hour that will be recorded and available for viewing after the lesson.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Students are encouraged to attend the daily live lesson but may choose to access the recording at another time in the day. Students work independently during the remaining course hours, which is asynchronous.➤ Students are able to connect with their teacher for one-on-one conferencing for assistance throughout the course.➤ Students are expected to log-in to Brightspace every day and should commit about six hours daily to their course. e-Summer courses count toward the OSSD and the mandatory e-Learning graduation requirement.
