

## Privacy Policy for Courtside Scoreboard

Courtside Scoreboard ("we," "our," or "the App") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we handle information when you use our mobile application.

### 1. Information Collection and Use

Courtside Scoreboard does not collect, store, or transmit any personal identification information (PII) to external servers.

- **Rosters and Game Data:** All player names, numbers, and game statistics are stored locally on your device's internal storage. We do not have access to this data.
- **PDF Generation:** When you generate a PDF report, the App requires access to your device's "Downloads" folder to save the file. This process happens entirely on-device.

### 2. Permissions

The App may request the following permissions to function correctly:

- **Storage/Media Access:** Required to save generated PDF match reports and CSV data to your device.
- **Internet Access:** Required exclusively for processing In-App Purchases through the Google Play Billing Library.

### 3. In-App Purchases (Google Play Billing)

Our App offers a "Premium Upgrade." All financial transactions are handled securely by the Google Play Store.

- We do not collect or store your credit card numbers, billing addresses, or banking information.
- We only receive a notification from Google Play confirming whether a purchase was successful to unlock your Premium features.

### 4. Third-Party Services

The App uses the following third-party services which may collect information used to identify you:

- **Google Play Services:** Used for app distribution and security.
- **Google Play Billing:** Used for processing premium upgrades. View Google's Privacy Policy [here](#).

### 5. Data Retention and Deletion

Since all game data is stored locally:

- You can delete your data at any time by deleting specific rosters within the app or by clearing the App Data in your Android Settings.
- Uninstalling the App will result in the deletion of all locally stored rosters and game history.

### 6. Children's Privacy

Our App does not knowingly collect any personal information from children. If you are a coach or parent entering player names, please ensure you have the necessary consent required by your local sports league or jurisdiction.
