MATH 100: Survey of Mathematics (3 credit course)

Includes a variety of selected mathematical topics designed to acquaint students with examples of mathematical and quantitative reasoning that demonstrate the beauty, power, clarity, and precision of mathematics.

The core course content includes deductive, numeric, symbolic, graphical and statistical algorithms and reasoning. MATH 100 is not intended as, and does not qualify as, a prerequisite for advanced mathematics courses.

Note: This course is a dual credit course. This course can count as a 4th non-AP math credit for your high school diploma toward an Academic or STEM Honors certificate (but not if taken the final semester of 12th grade year). This course will be weighted on a 4-point scale for GPA purposes. Math100 cannot be used to replace high school Algebra 1. Students are also responsible for textbook costs.

Prerequisite: EdReady Math Path 1 score of 72 or higher. This will be done during the enrollment process.
