



GoGuardian Badge

The Badge: The GoGuardian badge is issued to individuals that have demonstrated their ability to utilize GoGuardian to support their role in the district. Badge owners will demonstrate that they have the ability to use either GoGuardian Teacher or GoGuardian Administrator and justify how it applies to their setting/curriculum.

How to earn this badge: You may choose from one of the following options to earn the GoGuardian badge:

Pathway 1:

- ☐ Complete the [GoGuardian Teacher training course](#) or the [GoGuardian Admin training course](#)
- ☐ Reflect on how using GoGuardian will assist you in your role in the district. This may be in written or video form.
- ☐ Complete the [GoGuardian Teacher exam](#) or the [GoGuardian Administrator exam](#).
- ☐ Submit proof of completed training, passed exam, and your reflection as evidence to earn the badge.

Pathway 2:

- ☐ Create a screencast of your current GoGuardian Teacher dashboard.
- ☐ Describe an overview of any current classes, scenes, etc you have created.
- ☐ Describe how you manage your classroom with commands like open and close Chrome tabs, and lock and unlock student screens.
- ☐ Show how to keep track of student web activity with the Timeline and Screens views.
- ☐ Show how to enroll, exclude, and remove students from classrooms.
- ☐ Show how to import and use Google Classroom with GoGuardian Teacher.
- ☐ Show how to use chat to directly and discreetly talk with individual student.
- ☐ Show how to access student browsing history from past classroom sessions.
- ☐ Show how to get help with GoGuardian's help center.
- ☐ Save your screencast to Google Drive. Submit a publicly shared link to your evidence.

Pathway 3:

- ☐ If you currently hold a certification from GoGuardian, provide proof of your current status as well as details on how using GoGuardian has improved your role in the district. Evidence can be a written narrative or in video form. Please submit a link to your evidence below.

Pathway 4:

- ☐ [Schedule a 1:1 or small group coaching session](#) with the Director of Technology & Digital Learning who can provide the training needed to earn the badge.
