

What We Did During Week Twenty-four

We had another great week! If your child was at school on Friday, I am happy to say they are done with their body book—woohoo! The last system page was the nervous system, which we completed on Wednesday, and students glued their cover pages on Friday!

Besides completing their body book, students finished learning about the nervous system. One activity that we did was using both their dominant and non-dominant hand to write and draw! We started out "easy" by drawing some of the shapes we are working with in Number Corner, then it got more challenging! We had a lot of fun and learned that it is good to have a non-dominant hand because that hand has different jobs and tasks than our dominant hand does! It actually helps us problem-solve better-neat!

In Math, students continued to make observations for the February Number Corner calendar. They are learning about different attributes of shapes. The shapes they are working with are parallelograms, rhombuses, squares, rectangles, and triangles. Each day we discuss how many sides each shape has, how many vertices, and whether the two shapes are congruent or not. They also completed the last page of the latest unit test, which will be used for trimester 2 grades.

Home learning (DOT binders) were not sent out on Friday! The only assignment was to have a discussion with your child about a question they still have about the human body so they can start researching that question tomorrow.
