

- Short /e/: It's important to note that vowels can make 2 sounds, the short sound, and the long sound. Unit 2, Week 1 emphasizes the short /e/ sounds as in: beg, mess, and sell. Words such as: read, she, and seed are examples of words with the long /e/ sound.

• Onset & Rime: The "onset" is the initial phonological unit of any word (e.g. b in beg) and the term "rime" refers to the string of letters that follow, usually a vowel and final consonants (e.g. eg in beg).
