Logging in

Before you can login you must connect to your home wifi or the district wifi. When you power on the Chromebook you will see a message that says "Network not available". You will then see a list of available networks. Connect to your network and type your wifi password.

To login to a Chromebook, use the student's email address. Their password is the full 8 digit birthdate.


Password: 8 digit b-day (mmddyear)

Logging Out and Shutting Down

 Go to the bottom right corner and click on your picture/icon and shut down by clicking the Power icon or pressing the power button until the screen goes black.

Troubleshooting

• Shutting down the Chromebook and restarting it will correct most issues you may have.



Keyboard Shortcuts and Touchpad Gestures

- 1. The mousepad/trackpad
 - a. Two-finger scroll
 - b. Two-finger click = right click
- 2. Keyboard Shortcuts
 - a. Caps Lock ALT + Search
 - b. Screenshot Ctrl + screenshot button (rectangle with 2 lines to the right)
 - c. Shortcuts list Ctrl + Alt +?

Icon	Key	Description
(Back	Displays the previous page in your browser history.
← →	Forward	Displays the next page in your browser history.
G	Reload	Reloads your current page.
7.	Full screen	Opens your page in full-screen mode.
	Display apps	Displays open apps. NOTE: Pressing this button in conjunction with ctrl takes a screenshot.
o	Brightness down	Decreases the screen brightness incrementally as long as you hold down the key. $ \\$
¢	Brightness up	Increases the screen brightness incrementally as long as you hold down the key. $ \\$
*	Mute	Mutes speaker sound.
•	Volume down	Decreases speaker volume incrementally as long as you hold down the key. $\label{eq:continuous} % \begin{center} cente$
€	Volume up	Increases speaker volume incrementally as long as you hold down the key.

Reminders

- Keep your Chromebook secure and in the case at all times.
- Do not leave your Chromebook unattended.
- Check your keyboard before closing the screen. Make sure there are no pens, pencils or earbuds on the keyboard.
- Keep up with the charger. Students are expected to bring their Chromebook fully charged each day.
- Do not bring food or drink near your Chromebook
- Do not keep it in your hot or cold car or in an unlocked car or in open view in your car for anyone to see.
