



**TREATY OF MUTUAL RECOGNITION AND DIPLOMATIC
RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE KINGDOM OF MAYURSA
AND**

THE UNITED KINGDOM OF CREEK AND LAKE

Signed on the **7th** day of the month of **August** in the
Gregorian Year of **2023** under the joint consent of both the states

1. Effective immediately, both **Mayursia** and the **United Kingdom of Creek and Lake**, hereby referred to as parties, will acknowledge and recognize one another as sovereign and independent nations.
2. Both the parties pledge mutual recognition and respect for each other's symbols, territories, legal systems, institutions, traditions, culture, laws, and authorities. Furthermore, they commit not to intervene in each other's internal affairs, fostering a foundation of trust and sovereignty in their relationship.
3. Both parties agree to resolve conflicts and differences through dialogue and diplomatic channels, promoting peaceful and constructive resolution of disputes.
4. If faced with unconstitutional or unlawful claims from the other party, the other party shall not recognize them and may reconsider diplomatic ties with

the aggressing third party, as determined through diplomatic dialogue, to uphold its governance and territorial integrity.

5. The parties mutually pledge to support each other in resisting any forced foreign, third-party influence that may threaten their social, cultural, or economic integrity, forging a strong alliance based on shared interests.
6. Both parties retain sovereignty to establish relations and sign treaties with other nations or entities without obligating the other.
7. Once ratified, the treaty remains in force indefinitely, unless one signatory party denounces it in writing. Inactivity by either party for over six months without prior notice renders the treaty null and void.
