Additional information:

Students are expected to gain 10 public health days (PH – to be completed by consolidation please) and 5 *alternative placement days - these are counted in the 112.5 minimum practice days required. School Nurses, you may move this week if this is not a good week for arranging a placement.

It is expected that you will work more hours in placement than the required minimum. Your Alternative placement week can move to one of your annual leave weeks in August if this is agreed with your CPA or to another week in September if this were more appropriate (school nurses for example). You will not be able to bank your annual leave please take this as scheduled.

****Study days during consolidation** are to be used for the e-portfolio work and you will work 5 days in practice once the portfolio is submitted.

Changing Placements: It is expected that you have two placements in your year of study. This is to comply with the NMC (2019) SSSA requirements to have two assessors in your programme. **When you change your placement will be arranged by your CPA's and communicated to you at the start of the course.**

In this year of study (January to January) we have built in 4 weeks in the programme where you can either remain in your first placement after your annual leave in August a complete outstanding work in the caseload.

Use the 4 weeks to settle into your consolidated placement.
