- Water bottle
- Pencils, pens
- Science: a method for taking and referencing notes (notebook and pencil, or binder and markers, or laptop, etc.)
- English: Composition notebook and a folder, writing utensils
- Mathematics: 1.5" 3-ring binder, loose leaf paper, graph paper
- Spanish: lined paper, folder or binder, pens of different colors for taking notes
- Latin: lined paper; folder or binder
- Ancient History: lined paper; folder or binder
