I am a Mandated Reporter

This means: If I have <u>reasonable cause</u> to believe that a <u>child</u> has experienced <u>abuse or neglect</u>, I must report information to <u>child and family services</u> and/or <u>law enforcement</u> within 48 hours.

<u>Reasonable Cause</u>: this means I witness or receive written or verbal reports alleging abuse or neglect of a child.

<u>A Child</u>: this means someone under the age of 18.

Abuse or Neglect: this means sexual abuse, sexual exploitation, or injury of a child by any person under circumstances which cause harm to a child's health, welfare, or safety.

<u>Child and Family Services</u>: A Child Protective Service intake screener will take my report 1-866-829-2153.

<u>Law Enforcement</u>: I will call the school resource officer or dial 911 to find out where to report my information.

I am a School District Employee:

If you share information about <u>suicidal thoughts/behaviors and/or Self Harm</u>If you are in immediate danger I will stay with you. I will connect you with resources (school counselor, specialist, administrator). As school professionals, there is a process as they work with your caregiver/legal guardian and talk about safety.
