



INTERNATIONAL COACHING ENRICHMENT CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME (ICECP) 2026-2027

As part of the application process, applicants need to provide personal data (passport, etc.); professional background information related to their coaching experience and respond to the following questions: :

1. Name of Applicant (as per passport): Apenisa. Sabui. Saukuru
2. Date of birth: 8th April 1974
3. National Coach of (name of sport – must be a sport on the Olympic program): Beach and Indoor Volleyball
4. Qualification of Coach (copy of certification/accreditation): FIVB Level 1,
5. What are your objectives and expectations in participating in the ICECP program?
6. What is your National Federation's expected goals and end results from participating in the ICECP?
7. What is the title of your proposed project?
8. Which particular area of coaching will be addressed? (Coaching education, youth sport development, long term athlete development, high performance management, talent identification, grassroots programming and or development).
9. What are the objectives of your project? For example, your proposed project must have as its main objective: Improve some aspect of the sporting infrastructure in the home country, general and specific to a particular sport. Please see ICECP brochure for a list of possible topics.
10. What are the reasons for your choice? Please explain your personal reasons for wishing to improve the selected area within your country's sporting infrastructure.
11. How will you evaluate the success of your project (e.g. number of participants, creation of curriculum, improvement in performance of athletes, development of athlete development pipeline, etc)?
12. Submit a copy of your National Federation support letter
13. Curriculum vitae (CV)
14. Copy of Passport – must be valid for at least 6 months after the final date of the program ie November 2026
15. Submit medical certificate
16. Submit letter of support from National Federation

Applicants for an Olympic Solidarity scholarship must be a coach with the following characteristics:

- be fluent in reading, writing and speaking English; interviews will be performed to ensure English proficiency;
- belong to a federation of a sport on the Olympic program;

- be an official coach of the National Federation or affiliated club – open to coaches from all sports, however preference will be given to coaches in the following sports: Archery, Athletics, Basketball, Boxing, Judo, Rowing, Swimming, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Volleyball, Weightlifting
- be active and able to prove that they have practical experience as a coach at national/international level

Applications to be submitted to FASANOC, 17 Bau Street, Suva, or emailed to lyndall@fasanoc.org.fj no later than **Monday 09 February 2026**. No late applications will be accepted. The successful applicant will be required to attend an interview at FASANOC to finalise the project and application.
