
# English 2 Honors Summer Assignment 2024 The Color of Water by James McBride



This is a required summer assignment for any student enrolled in Honors English 2 for the 2024-2025 school year. It will be due on the first day of instruction in August. Be sure to complete the list of assignments below by the first day of instruction.

Due the first day of instruction is August 13th. **Bring your completed summer assignment on August 13th.** This is a C-Day so it does not matter what period you have me, as I will see all 6 periods that day. All assignments must be available **digitally** on Google Docs (the <u>one-pager</u> is the only exception which will be turned in physically).

**WARNING**: Not doing your summer assignment is not a proper excuse to make a last-minute change to your schedule and drop to CP, and your request to drop Honors will NOT be honored. Signing up for Honors is a commitment. Make sure to make a schedule for yourself this summer and stick to it. Expect 4-5 hours of homework a week when the semester begins.

You will need to make a digital copy for each of these assignments and type directly on the assignment (except for the one-pager which must be done by hand). Assignment number five must be typed on the "The Color of Water Character Analysis Worksheet/One-Pager" document and turned in to turnitin.com within the first week of school to check for plagiarism/AI. Your teacher will show you how to join their Turnitin.com classroom during the first week of school (you should already have a Turnitin.com account from last year, if you do not, your teacher will show you how to make an account during the first week of school). You do not need to submit anything before the first week of school BUT your assignments must be FINISHED.

### 4. Read The Color of Water by James McBride

<u>Directions:</u> If you are able to get a copy of the book, we highly suggest it. Amazon and <u>Reader's Books</u> (local book store) are great for this. Be prepared <u>for a test</u> on the novel during the first week of school. Yes, you have to read the Epilogue.

- ★ NOTE: The book is narrated by James McBride, but there are chapters that are narrated by his mother, Ruth McBride. These chapters are written in *italics*.
- ★ PDF of the novel: This is a free pdf version of the book in case you cannot purchase one
- ★ <u>Audiobook</u>: No free audiobook available. This audiobook is only available if you have Spotify premium. There are also audiobooks on sites like Audible.
