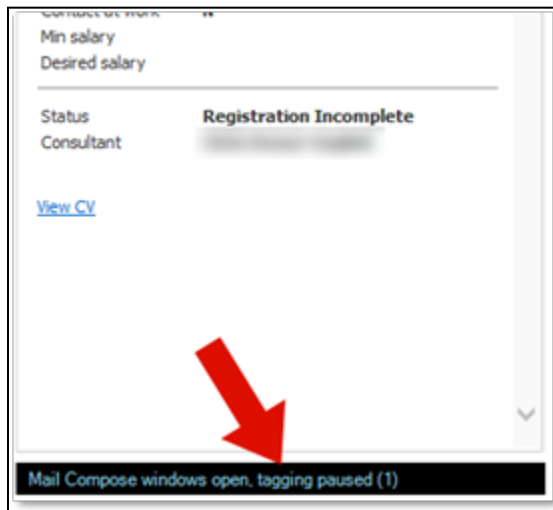

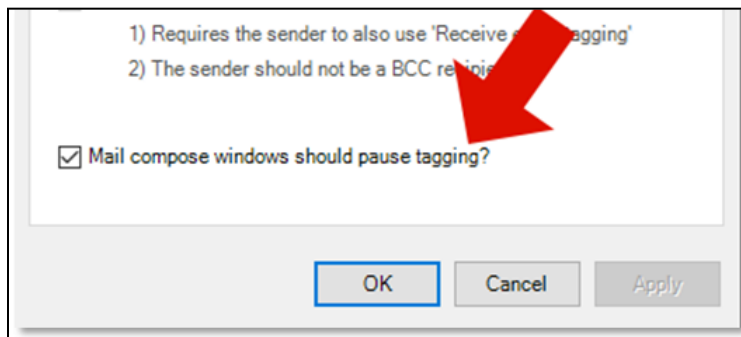
Description	Release Notes
Iframe removal	You may be aware that Google Chrome recently made some changes to prevent security risks with iframes, which introduces a negative impact on Adapt screens. Adapt currently uses iframes to render some of the pages in the UI. For example, the different sections on the Candidate Profile screen are currently displayed using iframes. For the last few months, we have been working hard to remove future potential breaking changes from Chromium updates, by removing our use of iframes in the core navigable display elements where possible.

Add status bar and new setting to prevent instances of items not being tagged due to an open mail compose window	Some items are not being tagged because they are paused due to a mail compose window being open, which is expected behaviour. To make users aware when tagging is paused, a new status bar has been added to the AOA window. The message reminds users when tagged items are queued up.	AD-12325

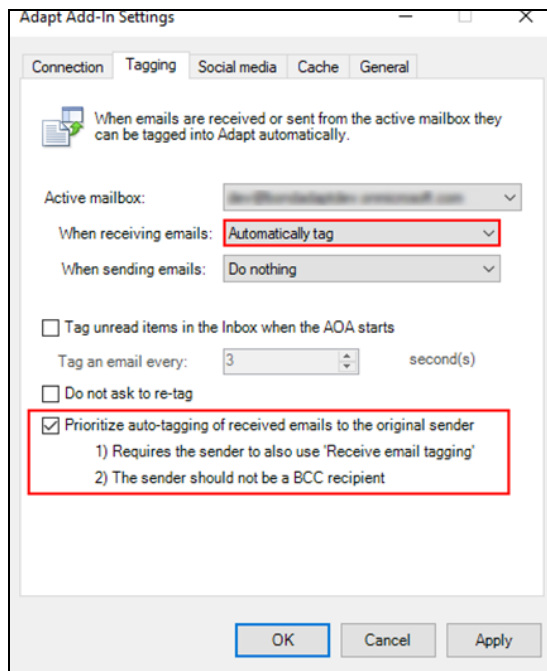


In addition, a new AOA user setting has been added to allow tagbacks to occur even when a user has a compose window open. This setting is disabled by default.



Note: This can affect system performance during tagback, and it is recommended to leave the pause feature enabled and to not leave compose windows open for long periods.

Allow already-tagged emails to be forwarded and tagged again	When a tagged email is forwarded, it will now be tagged again. Previously AOA would skip tagging of already tagged emails.	AD-12280
Add option to grant the sender priority in tagging emails	An option has been added to prioritize auto-tagging of received emails to the original sender. When this option is enabled, automatic tagging will be deferred to the original sender if the sender is also one of the recipients. This is to prevent colleagues of the sender from tagging emails before the sender receives their copy, resulting in the email appearing in the Journal as tagged by someone other than the original sender. Considerations:

- This feature is only applicable when receiving emails and using the ***Automatically Tag*** or the ***Prompt to Tag*** options.
- The ***Prioritize Auto Tagging...*** option needs to be enabled by every user in the team.
- The feature is only effective when the sender, and at least one other consultant, is listed as one of the recipients (To: or CC: but not BCC:). If the sender is not one of the recipients, the email will be auto tagged by the receiving user as expected.
