34. Parking and Transit

34.1 General Conditions. The University and the Union agree reducing the University's carbon footprint is a mutual goal.

34.3 Parking. ESEs will be eligible to park in designated University parking areas in accordance with University policies. The University may establish and charge parking fees, assess fines for violations of motor vehicle and parking regulations, order the removal of vehicles parked in violation of regulations at the expense of the violator, and seek collection of any unpaid fines. The University will provide thirty (30) calendar days advance written notice to the Union of any proposed change or increase in annual or quarterly permits and hourly rates for parking access.

34.6 University Parking and Transportation Advisory Committee. In the event that a committee of representatives from the University's unions (consisting of up to two (2) appointed representatives from each of the University's unions, with each union casting a single vote) is formed to address parking related topics, the Union will have the right to select its committee representative(s). UAW will delegate its authority to bargain any such issues to the committee.
