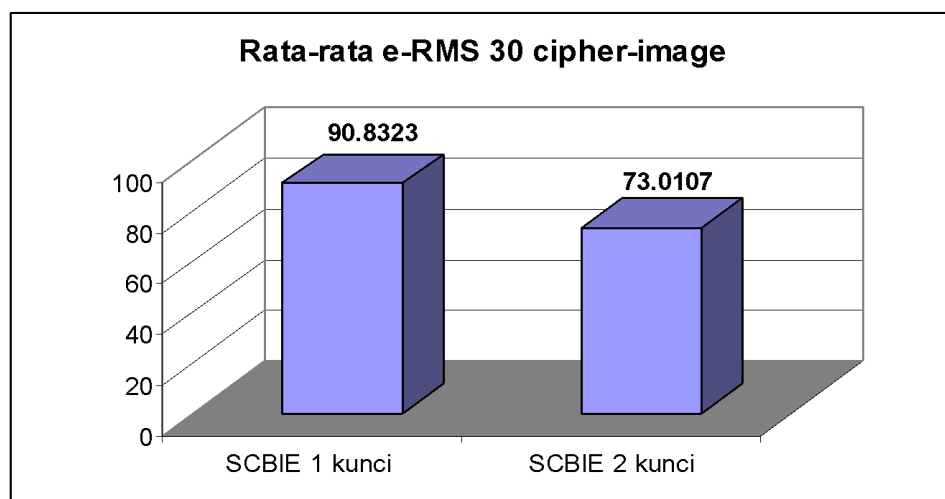


Figure 1. Rata-rata e-RMS 30 cipher-image (Cambria font 10, Center, Spacing 1)
