



Florida Fair Elections Suggests the House Make The Following Changes to the Elections Bill (House Bill 7067):

Florida Supervisors Must Accept Information On Ineligible Voters from the public

The Supervisor of Elections should be required to accept information from anyone with credible written documentation that a voter is ineligible, not just governmental entities. Limiting input to governmental entities is an attempt to silence the people of Florida who often have the most recent documented information on ineligible voters

- Senate Bill: Line 420 and Line 780 of SB7050(333316)
- House Bill: **S 98.075** Amend HB7607 Line 729 by inserting “**or any person with credible written documentation**”. **S 98.093** Amend HB7067 Line 1081 by inserting “**or any person with credible written documentation**”.

Do Not Delay The Conduct Of Elections Report

The Conduct of Elections report (a county level report documenting issues with the election) is being delayed until 20 business days after the state certification of the election. This will not be available to candidates soon enough to challenge their elections because they must challenge within 10 days of the state certification (102.168(2))

- Senate Bill: Line 1939 of SB7050 (333316)
- House Bill: **S 102.141** Amend HB7067 Line 2206 by removing all changes on lines 2206,2207, 2208, 2209, 2210, and 2211.
