

Privacy Policy for To Do List & Widgets

Introduction

To Do List & Widgets ("us", "we", or "our") operates the To Do List & Widgets mobile application (the "App"). This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of non-personally identifiable information we receive from users of the App.

We use your non-personally identifiable information only for providing and improving the App. By using the App, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

Information We Do Not Collect

To Do List & Widgets is designed to respect your privacy. We do not collect, store, or transmit any personal data to our servers. Specifically:

- We do not require an account or registration
- We do not collect your name, email address, phone number, or any other personally identifiable information
- We do not track your location
- We do not use third-party analytics services
- We do not display advertisements

Local Data Storage

All your tasks, lists, notes, and preferences are stored locally on your device. We do not have access to this data.

Widgets

The App provides home screen widgets that display your lists and tasks. Widget data is read from your local on-device storage and is rendered directly on your device. We do not transmit any widget data to external servers.

Apple Calendar Integration

The App requests access to your device's Calendar via Apple's EventKit framework so that you can view and manage events alongside your tasks within the App. This data remains on your device and is managed by iOS. We do not transmit your calendar data to any external servers.

You can revoke calendar access at any time in your device's Settings → Privacy & Security → Calendars.

Log Data

The App does not collect log data or usage statistics. If a crash occurs, basic crash reports may be transmitted to Apple as part of your device's standard iOS diagnostics, which is governed by Apple's privacy policy and not by us.

Children's Privacy

Our App does not address anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under 13.

Security

The security of your data is important to us. Since all data is stored locally on your device, its security relies on the security of your device. We recommend using a strong device passcode and Face ID/Touch ID.
