Position: Nature area Director (NAD)

Location: Hoyt Scout Reservation, 3 Marchant Road, Redding, CT

Duration: 4 weeks, beginning June 26- July 1 and also July 11- July 30

Work Hours: Approximately 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday

Qualifications:

The NAD shall be age 16 or greater. As a condition of employment, the NAD shall register as a member of Boy Scouts of America (BSA) if not already registered. Registration with BSA is mandatory because of our camp's accreditation requirements.

The NAD shall complete BSA Youth Protection Training (online self-study).

Reports to: Day Camp Program Director

Responsibilities:

The NAD works under the direct supervision of the Program director. They are responsible for becoming familiar with the pre-designed activities as developed by the Program Director and present these activities to multiple groups of campers throughout the day. Other aspects of this position include preparing the supplies prior to the beginning of each day of camp, instructing, guiding, and assisting campers as they complete these projects, and maintaining all equipment used for their area.

The NAD will participate in the daily opening ceremony and will be in charge of one camp-wide presentation at this ceremony (weather rock, spirit totem, service totem, etc.)

The NAD works in coordination with the other Area Directors to complete housekeeping duties such as setting up and breaking down for the day, and maintaining the cleanliness of their area.

The NAD is required to attend and participate in pre-camp training.

The NAD may also be required to chaperone field trips as well as on a bus transporting campers to and from remote pick up/drop off locations.

Mandated Reporter:

The NAD is considered a Mandated Reporter for instances of suspected child abuse or neglect under the rules and regulations of the State of Connecticut Office of Children and Families and the Boy Scouts of America.

The NAD shall immediately report any instances of suspected child abuse or neglect to the Camp Director, or in the absence of the Camp Director to the Connecticut Yankee Council Scout Executive or his Designee.
