The Culinary Assistant will help Culinary Educators teach cooking classes for Apples to Zucchini Cooking School. In this position you will deliver cooking classes to various groups in school and non-profits. Our program offers hands-on cooking classes, teaching children, teens and adults how to prepare nutritious, delicious, and affordable meals made from seasonal and local ingredients. The goal of these cooking classes is to introduce kids to foods they may not be familiar with, teach them how to cook a new recipe, and have them try nutritious food that may become a new part of their diet. The Culinary Assistant responsibilities and duties may include but are not limited to the following:

- Assist in cooking classes using prepared recipes and lesson plans.
- Provide instruction on cooking, table setting and sanitation practices in the kitchen.
- Share culinary terminology, food cuisines, and general food knowledge.
- Maintain the equipment and supplies of AtoZ.
- Track time in AtoZ communication tool Connecteam.

- Prior experience teaching children and teens (ages 5 - 18)
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to connect with volunteers
- Exceptional time management, organizational and problem-solving skills

- Reliable and diligent worker
- Able to deliver positive food messages
- Available in the afternoons, when classes will be conducted.

Transportation
