

## INFORMATION FOR DAY CAMPERS

### **Sunday: Day campers will need to be in Presser for the 2:00 general meeting**

Day campers should plan to participate fully in all camp activities, including the evening programs. Day campers will need to be on campus starting Sunday at 2:00pm, and by 8:00 am Monday through Thursday for their first rehearsal or class. Though each night is slightly different, campers can generally be picked around 9:00 pm – see [evening schedule](#) for more details.

#### **A. MEALS - Based on what you selected at registration, there are 2 options**

**Option 1:** Your camp fees include lunch and dinner. No breakfast or snacks included. You will be issued an ID card.

**Option 2:** No meals are provided. You may eat in the cafeteria by paying at the door. Food is also available at Starbucks, McDonald's, Taco Bell, East of Chicago Pizza, China King and Subway (all on Main Street). Going home or packing your lunch is fine as well. You will not be given an ID card.

- B. Camp policy states that resident campers may not visit your home or ride in your car.
- C. All rules and regulations apply to day campers as well as resident campers.
- D. Day campers are welcome to visit the dorms with the other campers during the day. However, you are not permitted to stay overnight.
- E. Day campers are required to remain on campus for any and all required rehearsals and activities in the evenings. You are also welcome to attend any non-required activities.
