

RITUALS & ARCANES PROCEDURES

The following archive contains a collection of documented rituals associated with the Arcane, categorized and studied by O.M.E.N occult research divisions. Rituals are structured methods of manipulating metaphysical laws through combinations of:

- spoken incantation
- symbolic gestures
- ritual markings
- materials or ingredients
- sacrifice

All of which collectively interact with and manipulate an unknown force of omnipresent energy designated *the arcane*.

Rituals are separated into 3 broad categories based on their severity and duration of effects:

- *SPELLS*

Temporary or immediate effects with relatively lower complexity, usually maintained solely through concentration.

- *HEXES*

Lingering metaphysical afflictions or alterations which are generally reversible or fade overtime

- *CURSES*

Permanent or self-sustaining metaphysical conditions that remain until actively broken

Completed rituals have 3 possible outcomes:

- Ritual Success

The supernatural effects manifested as intended

- Ritual Failure

No supernatural effects resulted from ritual activity

- Ritual Collapse

Intended supernatural effects did not occur and

Ritual collapse refers to destabilization during execution, often resulting in unintended or catastrophic effects dependent on the specific ritual or branch of magic.

The following rituals represent only a fraction of known spellcraft. O.M.E.N researchers estimate thousands of functioning rituals exist across human history, many likely lost through language extinction or incomplete documentation. The procedures listed within this archive are simply among the most consistently utilized, practical, or powerful rituals currently employed by O.M.E.N field operatives, occult researchers, and sanctioned practitioners.

The development of Catalysts during the late 5th century additionally allowed certain rituals to be partially embedded into physical objects through a hybridization of Alchemical enchantment and one or more magical branches. Once properly constructed, these catalysts — such as staffs, rings, weapons, or relics — may produce simplified spell effects through only verbal incantation and symbolic gestures, bypassing much of the normal ritual process.

NECROMANCY RITUAL ARCHIVE

Branch Classification: NECROMANCY

Necromancy concerns manipulation of mortality, vitality, bodily decay, aging, consciousness, and the metaphysical structure commonly referred to as the soul. Modern necromantic rituals are divided into three major classifications:

- Spells
- Hexes
- Curses

Spells are temporary and immediate effects.

Hexes are lingering metaphysical afflictions that remain reversible.

Curses are self-sustaining, permanent alterations unless actively broken.

BLOOD MAGIC/VOODOO RITUALS

Blood Magic, also referred to as “*Voodoo*” revolves around sympathetic connection through blood, suffering, emotional attachment, and vitality exchange. It is the main branch responsible for most curses or malevolent hexes.

Most Blood Magic rituals affect specific, targeted individuals, using collected biomaterial to create a metaphysical connection between the arcane and the target.

It hybridizes easily with nearly every other branch of magic.

THE BLOOD OATH

Classification

- Curse

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure/Collapse Risk

- 4/10

Materials / Components Required

- Fresh blood from both participants
- Pure steel ritual knife
- Wax candle
- Shared vow recited in Akkadian or Aramaic describing the terms of the agreement

Procedure

Both participants cut their palms and maintain physical contact over an open flame while reciting identical vows. The ritual finalizes once the candle extinguishes beneath the blood.

Intended Effects

Creates a permanent soul-binding agreement between both individuals. Knowingly violating the agreement causes escalating physical distress, and eventually death in the violating participant.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- obsessive emotional attachment between both or either participant towards the other
 - unintended consistent or spontaneous physical distress in one or both participants regardless of their actions
 - soul/identity merging
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THE RABID SOUL

Classification

- Hex

Hybridization

- Druidic Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 5/10

Duration

- 1-12 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Human or primate blood
- Fermented alcohol
- Blackthorn root
- Rhythmic chanting in Proto-Germanic or Latin

Procedure

Participants ingest the prepared mixture while seated within a ritual circle drawn with blood. Chanting gradually synchronizes breathing and heartbeat patterns between participants and increases the duration of the hex.

Intended Effects

Temporary enhancement of:

- aggression
- strength
- stamina
- pain tolerance
- reflexes

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- cardiovascular rupture
 - psychotic violence often tied to cannibalistic behavior
 - muscle or skin tearing
 - permanent adrenal damage

THE HOLLOWING CURSE

Classification

- Curse

Hybridization

- Prophetic Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 8/10

Materials / Components Required

- Hair, teeth, or blood from target
- Human effigy or preserved likeness
- Pure silver pins
- Thirty-day lunar cycle
- Funerary invocations in Coptic or Aramaic

Procedure

The practitioner repeatedly mutilates symbolic organs on the effigy, coated with the biomaterials of the target, during nightly ritual cycles while reciting funerary invocations at the same time each night for up to 30 days.

Intended Effects

Gradual erosion of:

- empathy
- joy
- fear
- emotional attachment
- self-preservation instinct

Tied to many cases of mental illness and depression.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- effects rebound onto the caster
- shared reactions to emotional stimuli/psychic connection

THE SIXTH NAME

Classification

- Hex

Hybridization

- Prophetic Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 6/10

Duration

- 1-8 days

Materials / Components Required

- Target's full birth name written six times
- Blood from immediate family member
- Preserved human or primate tongue drenched in oil
- Incomplete spoken recitations in Ancient Greek or Aramaic

Procedure

Each name is written on a separate parchment in blood, and then individually burned with the lit tongue while the practitioner speaks the target's full name and progressively degrades pronunciation with every repetition. Ritual must be repeated and renewed to continue effects.

Intended Effects

Observers of the target gradually:

- fail to recognize the target
- forget facial details
- overlook their presence
- question whether they existed at all

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- effects rebound onto caster
- catastrophic self-amnesia
- psychosis
- identity degradation

THE HUNGER

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 3/10

Duration

- 4-30 days

Materials / Components Required

- Salted liver
- Carnivore teeth
- Ritual dining arrangement
- Consumption litany in Latin or Coptic

Procedure

The practitioner conducts a shared ritual meal with the target while reciting consumption prayers over the prepared remains.

Intended Effects

Victims become psychologically incapable of feeling satiated while eating.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- organ necrosis
- compulsive cannibalistic urges
- metabolic collapse
- rebound affliction

THE BLEEDING SOUL

Classification

- Curse

Hybridization

- Spectral Magic

Complexity

- 7/10

Materials / Components Required

- Preserved human or primate heart
- Target blood
- Fermented wine
- Heart-shaped ritual geometry
- Grief invocations in Aramaic

Procedure

The practitioner douses the preserved heart with alcohol and the target's blood while reciting specific Aramaic invocations depending on the particular intended effects.

Intended Effects

Designated emotional states trigger:

- migraines
- vomiting
- hemorrhaging
- muscular paralysis
- cardiac distress

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- effects rebound into the caster
- complete emotional numbness in target
- nervous system failure

Classification

- Hex

Hybridization

- Prophetic Magic influence

Complexity

- 8/10

Duration

- 30 minutes to 12 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Shared blood dilution
- Multiple participants wearing no clothing
- Circular ritual circles
- Mass chanting in Latin or Akkadian

Procedure

Participants gather within ritual circles drawn in blood while synchronized chanting and rhythmic movement gradually align emotional states.

Intended Effects

Participants begin sharing personal memories and emotions of:

- grief
- fear
- rage
- devotion
- euphoric emotional states

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- mob psychosis
 - emotional cascade events
 - homicidal mania
 - comatose states
 - mass suicide phenomena

BEAST BIRTH

Classification

- Curse

Hybridization

- Life Magic Green
- Magic influence

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 10/10

Materials / Components Required

- Human or primate infant blood
- Herbal mutagens
- Repeated human sacrifice
- Fertility invocations in Ancient Coptic

Procedure

The ritual is repeatedly conducted throughout pregnancy while the subject remains exposed to mutagenic herbal preparations and symbolic womb markings drawn in freshly killed blood.

Intended Effects

Artificial manipulation of fetal development potentially producing offspring with:

- supernatural affinity
- psionic sensitivity
- heightened aggression
- severe mutation

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- human-bestial hybrid birth
 - birth complications/defects
 - uncontrolled biological mutation
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SPECTRAL MAGIC RITUALS

Spectral Magic concerns interaction with incorporeal consciousness, postmortem entities, hauntings, ghost manifestations, and the separation between soul and body.

Among all necromantic disciplines, Spectral Magic possesses one of the highest documented ritual collapse rates, and an extremely high fatality rate among inexperienced practitioners.

This is likely due to the sheer variety in the threat and power level between ghost manifestations.

THE OPEN CURTAIN

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 5/10

Duration

- 1 minute to 3 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Covered mirror
- Fresh soil
- Multiple max candles
- Complete darkness
- Latin funerary invocation

Procedure

The practitioner conducts the ritual in complete darkness while standing on fresh soil before unveiling the mirror and lighting multiple candles simultaneously during the final stage of the invocation.

Intended Effects

Allows temporary communication with nearby dead consciousnesses.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- ghost possession
- insomnia
- establishment of a connection between the caster and a ghost manifestation, IE “hauntings”

THE CHAIN OF SAINT VITUS

Classification

- Hex

Hybridization

- Rune Magic influence

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 7/10

Duration

- 5 minutes to 3 months

Materials / Components Required

- Pure steel chains
- Burial nails
- Small particle substance such as sand, salt, or ash
- Circular ritual circles
- Latin binding prayers

Procedure

The practitioner constructs ritual restraints and circular ritual circles composed of sand or salt, around the targeted location or object before invoking containment prayers.

Intended Effects

Traps ghost manifestations inside the designated location for the duration or until the circle is broken

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- ghost possession
- entity strengthening/increased resistance from future rituals
- attraction of other ghost manifestations

BANISHMENT

Classification

- Curse (exorcism)

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 6/10

Materials / Components Required

- Small particle substance such as sand, salt, or ash
- Symbolic materials associated with the targeted ghost manifestation
- Latin and Aramaic funerary rites

Procedure

The practitioner casts ritual ash around the entity while continuously reciting dismissal rites and holding an object of sentimental value for the manifestation

Intended Effects

Permanently banishes the ghost manifestation from a designated location or individual.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- entity strengthening/increased resistance from future rituals
- ghost possession
- rebounds the curse of revenancy onto caster

IMPRISONMENT

Classification

- Hex (exorcism)

Hybridization

- Rune Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 8/10

Duration

- Dependent on age and power of targeted ghost manifestation

Materials / Components Required

- Ritual vessel or object (more potent when it is a symbolic item related to the targeted ghost manifestation)
- Small particles such as sand, salt, or ash
- Aramaic funerary invocations

Procedure

The spirit is forced or lured into the designated vessel through before the containment markings are sealed and funerary invocations are completed.

Intended Effects

Binds a ghost manifestation into a physical object.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- ghost possession
- entity strengthening/increased resistance to future rituals

SILENCING

Classification

- Curse (exorcism)

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 10/10

Materials / Components Required

- Preserved human or primate heart
- Wax candles
- Small particles like sand, salt, or ash
- Multi-hour funerary annihilation rite in Coptic

Procedure

The practitioner conducts simultaneous bloodletting with the targeted ghost manifestation or undead entity while reciting funerary invocations within a prepared burial circle composed of lit wax candles. The ritual is only complete once each candle has extinguished itself.

Intended Effects

Complete destruction of a target's soul.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- effects rebound onto caster
- ghost possession
- entity strengthening/resistance to future exorcism rituals
- soul/identity merging

NOMADIC SOUL

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 9/10

Duration

- 1-24 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Preserved human or primate skull
- Wax candles
- Personal belongings and/or human blood, sweat, urine, or tears
- Full-body ritual circle
- Complete sensory deprivation/meditation

Procedure

The practitioner enters a trance state within a sealed ritual circle composed of personal belongings or the caster's biomaterial while progressively slowing respiration and heartbeat through controlled breathing and incantation. The entirety of the ritual cycle they must remain staring at a preserved skull lit by candlelight.

Intended Effects

Temporarily separates the practitioner's soul from their physical body, allowing manifestation as an incorporeal entity capable of:

- flight
- invisibility
- intangibility
- limited possession

The body remains unconscious and vulnerable during the ritual.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- inability to return to the body
- comatose state
- ghost possession of the host body
- death

THE INVITATION

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 7/10

Duration

- 1 minute to 24 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Blood from the intended host
- Clear mirror
- Fresh soil
- Continuous Aramaic invitation rites

Procedure

The target is positioned standing on fresh soil before a mirror while the practitioner repeatedly weakens metaphysical resistance on the mirror by painting symbolic gestures with blood and through verbal invitation invocations.

Intended Effects

Allows nearby incorporeal entities to temporarily possess the designated individual.

Possessing entities typically gain:

- limited motor control
- speech
- partial sensory perception
- in extreme cases retaining abilities associated with revenant-class ghost manifestations

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- permanent possession
- psychosis
- soul/identity merging
- death

THE CORTÈGE

Classification

- Spell

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 8/10

Materials / Components Required

- Pure steel bells
- Fresh soil
- Wax candles
- Clear night sky
- Multi-voice funerary chanting in Latin

Procedure

The practitioner conducts repeated funerary invocations while standing on fresh soil, surrounded by lit candles, ringing multiple small bells in the middle of the night.

Intended Effects

Draws incorporeal entities from vast surrounding distances toward the ritual site.

The ritual appears particularly effective near:

- battlefields
- graveyards
- execution grounds
- mass casualty sites

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- hauntings

- localized reality distortion
 - ghost possession
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THE BONE SERVANTS

Classification

- Spell

Hybridization

- Rune Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 9/10

Materials / Components Required

- Human skeletal remains or corpses
- Pure steel nails
- Blood-infused binding resin
- Proto-Germanic command symbols
- Coptic command invocations

Procedure

The practitioner carves and places command sigils directly into the remains using nails before coating the body in binding resin and maintaining ritual concentration throughout activation and maintaining of the spell.

Intended Effects

Animates corpses or skeletons as temporary servants directly controlled by the practitioner's subconscious thought

These entities possess no consciousness (soul/memory/thoughts) and only limited autonomous movement, similar to a ghoulish-class ghost manifestation.

The practitioner maintains control through intense concentration.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- uncontrolled aggression/loss of command authority
 - accidental attraction of genuine ghost manifestations into the remains
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LIFE MAGIC RITUALS

Life Magic concerns preservation, restoration, bodily repair, illness removal, and lifespan manipulation through direct interaction with vitality and soul integrity.

While historically associated with benevolent practices, many Life Magic rituals involve dangerous vitality transfer, accelerated aging, or metaphysical destabilization that have been commonly abused throughout history— leading to extreme caution when attempting Life Magic rituals.

THE WHITE HAND

Classification

- Spell

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 3/10

Materials / Components Required

- Bowl of water

- Herbal salves
- Physical contact with the injured area
- Ancient Egyptian healing invocation

Procedure

The practitioner repeatedly washes the injured area while reciting healing prayers and maintaining physical contact.

Intended Effects

Accelerates:

- clotting
- tissue repair
- pain reduction
- infection resistance

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- uncontrolled tissue growth
- addiction
- partial sensory loss in either target or caster

THE GIFT OF BREATH

Classification

- Spell

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 6/10

Materials / Components Required

- Shared blood dilution
- Breath synchronization

- Gold-thread bindings
- Continuous Coptic vitality prayers

Procedure

The practitioner synchronizes breathing and heartbeat with the target while gradually transferring vitality between both individuals.

Intended Effects

Transfers physical vitality from one individual into another.

May temporarily:

- heal injuries
- restore stamina
- reduce illness
- reverse physical exhaustion

While transferring the healed effects to the caster, or vice versa.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- adverse effects rebound on both participants
- emotional synchronization

THE GARDEN OF EDEN

Classification

- Curse

Hybridization

- Druidic Magic
- Blood Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 9/10

Materials / Components Required

- Ritual greenhouse or garden
- Pure silver lined irrigation channels
- Seasonal renewal rites in Ancient Coptic or Sanskrit
- Consistent animal or human sacrifice

Procedure

The practitioner cultivates a biologically linked ecosystem over several years while continuously feeding vitality into the garden through ritual sacrifice.

Intended Effects

Greatly slows and in extreme cases reverses aging by drawing vitality from surrounding plant life and linked biological systems.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- rapid aging and bodily decay upon leaving the ritual grounds or renewal ritual failure or collapse
- surrounding ecosystem collapse causing immediate bodily deterioration
- rapid deterioration of the surrounding ecosystem extending up to 3 miles from the ritual site

RESURRECTION

Classification

- Spell

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 8/10

Materials / Components Required

- Shared blood transfer
- Heated ritual oils
- Gold needles
- Multi-person healing invocation in Coptic

Procedure

The ritual must begin immediately following clinical death while practitioners maintain synchronized incantation and direct bodily contact with the deceased.

Intended Effects

Restores bodily function shortly after death.

Note that ritual failure or collapse on a target becomes exponentially more common with multiple uses

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- severe memory loss
- emotional numbness
- soul/identity merging
- death in either the caster and/or target

THE GOLDEN NEEDLE

Classification

- Spell

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 7/10

Materials / Components Required

- Gold wire
- Pure silver needles

- Continuous Egyptian restoration prayers

Procedure

The practitioner physically traces damaged nerve pathways using gold thread while maintaining ritual concentration and reciting restoration invocations.

Intended Effects

Depending on usage, may restore:

- movement
- eyesight
- hearing
- speech
- nerve function

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- sensory distortion
- phantom pain
- involuntary muscle activity
- emotional hallucinations
- death

TRANSCERENCE

Classification

- Curse

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 10/10

Materials / Components Required

- Two wax candles
- Hair, blood, urine, tears, or sweat samples from both individuals
- Gold-thread bindings
- Aramaic invocations

Procedure

The practitioner binds both individuals within a ritual lifespan exchange while continuously feeding the flames their biomaterial throughout the night.

Intended Effects

Transfers lifespan from one individual into another.

One participant rapidly ages while the other regains youth and vitality.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- simultaneous cellular collapse
 - catastrophic aging and de-aging in both participants
 - death of all participants
 - soul/identity merging
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DIVINITY RITUAL ARCHIVE

Branch Classification: DIVINITY

Divinity concerns interaction with divine energies, daemonic entities, metaphysical domains, symbolic law, and external forces believed to originate beyond mortal consciousness.

Modern Divinity rituals are divided into:

- Rune/Totem Magic
 - Prophetic Magic
 - Creation Magic
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RUNE/TOTEM MAGIC RITUALS

Rune/Totem Magic revolves around symbolic markings, territorial authority, transformation, daemon interaction, and metaphysical boundaries. These rituals are generally more stable and longer-lasting than most other magical disciplines.

The effects of Rune/Totem Magic also drastically varies depending on the divine domain or specific daemonic entity the ritual is affecting.

Most Rune/Totem Magic rituals rely heavily on specific symbols, related to either the intended effects or the target of the ritual, to be present in some form.

THE WARD OF IRON ROOTS

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 5/10

Duration

- 1 day - dependent

Materials / Components Required

- Runestones carved with Proto-Germanic inscriptions
- Small dust-like materials such as sand, salt, or ash
- Circular boundary marks

Procedure

Runestones are positioned around a designated area while the practitioner marks the boundary with dust before reciting territorial invocations.

Intended Effects

Prevents or heavily distresses designated:

- supernatural entities
 - individuals
 - or metaphysical phenomena
- from entering the marked area.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- boundary inversion trapping occupants inside
- boundary blocks intended entities from entry

Classification

- Spell

Hybridization

- Creation Magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 9/10

Materials / Components Required

- Two prepared rune circles
- Symbolic carvings
- Multi-person chanting in Proto-Germanic

Procedure

Two linked ritual circles are activated simultaneously while practitioners maintain synchronized invocation.

Intended Effects

Creates a temporary portal between two prepared locations anywhere in the world.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- physical dismemberment
- random portal destabilization
- disappearance of participants
- spatial explosion release

SKIN CHANGER

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 7/10

Duration

- 5 minutes to 12 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Animal hide, hair, or blood
- Symbolic mask
- Ritual scarification in Proto-Germanic or Sanskrit

Procedure

The practitioner dons the ritual mask while consuming the designated animal biomaterial and carving symbolic markings into the skin.

Intended Effects

Allows temporary transformation into:

- animals
- or in rarer cases another human individual.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- permanent mutation
- identity degradation/feral psychosis
- incomplete and incredibly painful transformations

SUMMON FAMILIAR

Classification

- Spell

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 6/10

Materials / Components Required

- Carved animal bone effigies of the caster
- Circular territory markings
- Summoning chants in Proto-Germanic

Procedure

The practitioner establishes a marked territory before invoking and binding nearby spirit entities into the prepared effigies.

Intended Effects

Summons controllable animal-like spirit manifestations tied to the caster's will and soul that remain as long as concentration is held.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- hostile spirit behavior/loss of control
- spirit attachment
- attraction of ghost manifestations

PACK MENTALITY

Classification

- Hex

Hybridization

- Prophetic magic

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 4/10

Materials / Components Required

- Carnivorous animal blood
- Multiple participants
- A group hunting or aggression activity
- Repetitive territorial chants in Proto-Germanic

Procedure

Participants engage in ritual hunting activity with identical symbolic markings painted on each member in blood, and while maintaining synchronized chanting

Intended Effects

Enhances:

- territorial instinct
- group psychic connection
- hunting coordination
- fear suppression
- increased physical limits
- group aggression

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- uncontrollable violence
- pack psychosis
- predatory fixation
- long-term aggression disorders

THE SPIRIT MASK

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 10/10

Duration

1 minute to 24 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Symbolic ritual mask
- Hallucinogenic compounds
- Extended sensory deprivation
- Daemonic symbols scarred into the caster or participant's skin
- Summoning invocation in Proto-Germanic or Ancient Greek

Procedure

The practitioner undergoes prolonged isolation while repeatedly invoking a symbolic archetype or divine entity through ritual masking and hallucination induction. The ritual effect can then be renewed through donning the mask and repeating the invocations.

Intended Effects

Temporarily embodies traits associated with the invoked entity, potentially including:

- heightened strength
- altered personality
- prophetic speech
- physical mutation
- extreme aggression
- supernatural affinities

The specific empowerments and abilities are dependent on the daemonic entity or divine domain invoked.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- permanent identity destruction
- possession of a daemonic entity

- psychosis
 - irreversible bodily mutation
-

NATURURGY

Effectively, Natururgy is closely tied to observable physical laws, though still fundamentally dependent upon arcane principles and ritual structure to activate its supernatural effects.

Modern O.M.E.N classification divides Natururgy into three primary sub-branches:

- Alchemy
- Green Magic
- Elemental Magic

ALCHEMY RITUALS

Sub-Branch Classification: ALCHEMY

Alchemy concerns the permanent or temporary infusion of arcane properties into physical matter. Unlike most magical disciplines, Alchemy does not directly manipulate reality during casting — instead, it alters the properties of objects, materials, liquids, alloys, or compounds through precise formulaic ritual preparation.

Alchemy is the foundation of:

- enchanted weaponry
- supernatural containment materials
- catalyst construction
- ritual enhancement compounds

Unlike nearly every other magical discipline, most alchemical rituals contain no spoken incantation whatsoever and usually behave more like scientific formulas.

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 10/10

Duration

- 10 minutes - 3 hours

Materials / Components Required

- Enclosed ritual site
- Continuous fire in close proximity
- Uninterrupted meditation
- Thermal invocations in Old Chinese

Procedure

The practitioner gradually absorbs surrounding thermal energy during prolonged ritual exposure.

Intended Effects

Allows temporary manipulation of thermal temperatures to create ice and frost, or absorb heat.

Also allows for the temporary solidification of body parts into incredibly durable ice. The shattering of this ice results in catastrophic physical injury following the end of the hex duration.

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- frostbite
 - uncontrolled heat release/combustion
 - permanent ice-transmutation

THE STORM EYE

Classification

- Hex

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

- 8/10

Materials / Components Required

- Active stormfront
- Copper rods
- Multi-person weather invocation in Old Chinese

Procedure

Practitioners synchronize atmospheric pressure shifts through prolonged elemental invocation and ritual positioning.

Intended Effects

Temporarily stabilizes or redirects local weather systems including:

- rainfall
- snowfall

- hail
- wind direction
- lightning activity
- storm movement
- cloud movement

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- tornado formation
 - uncontrolled storm escalation
 - lightning strikes
 - regional environmental devastation

THE MAGE STORM

Classification

- Curse

Complexity / Estimated Ritual Failure Risk

10/10

Materials / Components Required

- Multiple practitioners
- Copper rods
- Outdoor ritual site
- Synchronized invocations in Old Chinese

Procedure

Practitioners synchronize massive-scale atmospheric instability through prolonged concentration and ritual weather manipulation.

Intended Effects

Capable of generating:

- firestorms
- flash floods
- hurricane-force winds
- tornadoes
- severe lightning storms

Potential Ritual Collapse Risks

- loss of command authority/uncontrollable supernatural weather events
- ecological devastation
- permanent regional climate destabilization
