Students with open periods:

- Some students may not be enrolled in one or more periods during the day
- Students who have an open period at the end of their academic day will be released for the day
- Students who have an open period in the middle of the day, between two academic periods, are required to stay on campus through the end of their academic day.
- Students who are released early may not be on other VUSD school campuses.

Campus Boundaries: Hang out with us in the quad! Students must stay within the gates at all times. Students MAY NOT hang out in the parking lot, the back of the school behind the black box, or the garden outside of the gates at any time. The gates at the front of campus will be closed during school hours (8:30-2:30). The gate next to the front office will remain open throughout the day. Students arriving late, leaving early, or going off campus for lunch will need to enter and exit through the gate next to the main office, please plan accordingly.

This year our Cafeteria will be serving breakfast before school beginning at 7:55. All students are able to have free meals once again this year! Students may choose between receiving free breakfast **or a nutrition snack** and all students will also receive lunch for free. If students would like to purchase additional food, they are able to do so in the cafeteria.

Cell phones and airpods take away from the learning environment and are not allowed to be out or used anywhere on campus during class time. Teachers will be monitoring this in their classrooms during class time. Staff will also be monitoring hallways and restrooms during class time. Students may not be on phones during class time anywhere on campus including hallways, the restroom and the quad. Students on cell phones during class time will have them taken to the office. If you have an emergency where you need to use your phone during class time anywhere on campus you must speak to and be with a staff member.

Out of class during class time: Students being in class during instructional time is important. Students frequently leaving class is a disruption to teaching and learning. Students should be using the restroom during breaks and only using the restroom during class time if it is an emergency. Every student who needs to be out of class during class time will be required to have a signed pass from their teacher to leave during class time and will need to leave their cell phone in the classroom. Restroom breaks are to be less than 5 minutes or students may use the restroom in the health office. Please do not plan on leaving class during instructional time unless it's an emergency.
