##### **AP testing is here! Just a few reminders about testing:**

- Read the email sent by Ms. Tedford with AP reminders
- Review the AP Terms and Conditions prior to testing
- DO NOT ARRIVE LATE to testing – morning testers must arrive at 7:30, afternoon testers at 11:30
- Late testers will not be permitted to test and will not be given a refund
- All testing is at the Wright Events Center immediately across the street from FTHS
- YOU must bring your charged chromebook, no chromebook, no testing – see the media center if you need a chromebook
- Students are expected to attend school before or after their AP test. We will excuse absences, ONLY when your parent calls in clearing your absence before or after testing. If parents don't email or call to clear your absence, it will be considered a truancy.

**Attention Students of Class of 2027: Check your emails now!**

Students who plan to drive to school during the '26-'27 school year may now apply to enter the lottery for our limited (50-60 spots) on-campus student parking, through June 4th. ONLY students may apply for parking and must do so when logged into their VUSD Google account. All parking spots at FTTHS are assigned, and the only way students may park in the assigned spots on campus is through following this process.

**Air guitar will be on Friday 5/22** and we will have a closed campus for all students through 2:35. All students, regardless of their grade, off campus pass or schedule will be required to stay until 2:35 on the 22nd. No students will be permitted to go off campus for lunch on the day of Air Guitar. Lunch will be available in the cafeteria and available for purchase as part of the food fair. Students who have work, have a reduced schedule, have medical appointments, or need to leave campus before 2:35 FOR ANY REASON will need to bring a note from a parent to leave early before the event begins. Students are also expected to sign out in the office. Please plan ahead and bring your note in the morning if you need to leave before 2:35.

**Friendly reminder-**We have had quite a few students arriving late and leaving early without stopping in the office. Students who do not stop in the office may not have absences excused. Mid-day absences may not be cleared after.

**Students with open periods:**

- Some students may not be enrolled in one or more periods during the day
- Students who have an open period at the end of their academic day will be released for the day
- Students who have an open period in the middle of the day, between two academic periods, are required to stay on campus through the end of their academic day.
- Students who are released early may not be on other VUSD school campuses.

**Campus Boundaries:** Hang out with us in the quad! Students must stay within the gates at all times. Students MAY NOT hang out in the parking lot, the back of the school behind the black box, or the garden outside of the gates at any time. The gates at the front of campus will be closed during school hours (8:30-2:30). The gate next to the front office will remain open throughout the day. Students arriving late, leaving early, or going off campus for lunch will need to enter and exit through the gate next to the main office, please plan accordingly.

If you have an emergency where you need to use your phone during class time anywhere on campus you must speak to and be with a staff member.

**This year our Cafeteria** will be serving breakfast before school beginning at 7:55. All students are able to have free meals once again this year! Students may choose between receiving free breakfast **or a nutrition snack** and all students will also receive lunch for free. If students would like to purchase additional food, they are able to do so in the cafeteria.

**Out of class during class time:** Students being in class during instructional time is important. Students frequently leaving class is a disruption to teaching and learning. Students should be using the restroom during breaks and only using the restroom during class time if it is an emergency. Every student who needs to be out of class during class time will be required to have a signed pass from their teacher to leave during class time and will need to leave their cell phone in the classroom. Restroom breaks are to be less than 5 minutes or students may use the restroom in the health office. Please do not plan on leaving class during instructional time unless it's an emergency.

**Please be aware that you should never** share personal information in response to emails sent to your VUSD email address. Any email asking for your personal details—such as passwords, social security numbers, or financial information—should be ignored and deleted immediately.

These emails are often attempts at phishing, which is a tactic used to steal sensitive information. Remember:

- VUSD will never ask for personal information via email.
- If you receive a suspicious email, do not click on any links or attachments.
