Google Drive / Google Classroom

Recently we have started using Google Drive/Google Classroom in our class. This is an online tool that saves our work in the cloud (we like to call it our "Sky Desk"). With this Sky Desk, we are able to do work at school AND home, as well as collaborate with each other on certain files.

This week the class was introduced to Google Draw - a program that lets you draw and write to show your thinking. We have created a drawing for your child to explore and learn this new program in a fun way. Your child has access to this at home.

Follow the steps below to log onto your child's Sky Desk and let the learning continue at home!

On a computer, open the CHROME¹ browser and type in the following URL:

google.wrdsb.ca




Once you press "Login" it will take you into your child's Google Drive. This is where all your child's files from school (or home) will be saved when working in their Google Drive. This Google Drive will remain your child's Sky Desk all through elementary school and until they are finished high school (if they stay within the Waterloo Region District School Board).


To have your child open his/her Google Draw file, follow these following steps:
