 - The Bullying Prevention Unit Home Links give students a chance to practice skills outside of the classroom and help families learn about the skills and concepts and begin to use them at home.
 - Home Links can also be useful for checking students' understanding and acquisition of the skills as they practice them in a non-school setting.
