

Template: Retrospective and Resolutions

How to use this template

- **Make a plan for *when* you're going to do this retrospective.** Set aside 2-3 hours to do it properly
- **Think about what you most want to get out of this retrospective.** Is it clarity on your values? A detailed analysis of the progress you've made towards your goals? A synthesis of your biggest learnings this year?
 - It can help to break this into Personal and Professional
- **Make a copy of this template**
- **Structure the template to best fit your needs.** Use the template as is, or alter it to fit your needs. This is *your* retrospective, and there are no hard and fast rules. Take stuff out or add it in as you like.
- **Get started!**
- **Optional: Using your 2021 Retrospective findings, set resolutions for 2022.**

Big events

Contextualize what you did this year with big life events that may have changed, stalled, or accelerated your goals.

Life

Have you had a baby? Did someone close to you die? Did you make a big life change like moving cities or buying a house?

Career

Did your job situation change? Were you promoted? Did you lose a job? Did you change careers?

External events

How are you feeling about what's happening in the world? Is there an event or happening that particularly affected you, and how?

Big picture

In this section, give an overarching summary of your year to build out an outline and get you ready to do a deeper dive. Break this into Personal and Professional.

Values

What were your values at the beginning of the year? What are your values now? Do your actions align to these values? What do I want more of in my life? Less?

Goals/Systems

What were your goals at the beginning of the year? What progress have I made on these goals? What did you not do that you said you would? Why?

Learnings

What did you learn this year? Intellectually, professionally, about the world, about yourself, about life? Where did you grow? Where did you fail/come short?

Well-being

How were you this past year: emotionally, physically, mentally, socially, financially? What brings me energy? What were some highs of the year? Lows?

Map it out

Take the year month by month. Map out happenings that came to mind in the previous two sections—big life events, big realizations—and also add any standout accomplishments or failures that come to mind.

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Nitty-gritty

Now it's time to flesh out the details. If you have goals, systems, or habits you were working towards in 2021, find information on your progress and record it.

Some of you may have tracked data on your goals throughout the year, which can give you a clear picture of where you've made progress. If you don't have detailed data, that's ok! Try your best to document what you can remember.

Break down your big picture goals and learnings into specifics. It can help at this point to use an external tool like Google Sheets or Coda to structure the information into a table, or a visual tool like MURAL if you prefer visual representations.

- 2) List out everything you'd like to achieve next year
- 3) Narrow down the list to your top prioritize
- 4) Create a structure to stay accountable and measure your progress
