In Alpine School District we strive to create positive learning environments that respond to student's academic, social and emotional needs. As such, we have collaborated with a university (BYU) to develop ASD's Culture, Climate, and Connection Survey.

Why did we create the Culture, Climate and Connection Survey?

To give schools data, through student voice, that can be used to develop and measure student connection and to improve the learning environment for all students.

Who will be taking the survey?

1. Students in grades 3-12. **Students may choose to take the survey in English or Spanish.**

What will take place during the administration of the survey?

1. Students will take the survey twice during the 2024-2025 school year (Fall & Spring).
2. Students will take the survey at school through a link in their email or on CANVAS/Google Classroom.
3. Classroom teachers will assist students in accessing the survey, reading instructions and questions.
4. Instructional time is vital to a student's academic success, so we will work diligently with school administrators to complete the survey during an appropriate time in the school day. On average the survey takes 10-15 minutes to complete.
5. Students are able to opt out of taking the survey at any time.

Is the survey confidential?

This internal survey is **anonymous** and will not become a part of an individual student's academic record. Data will be aggregated for school/district-wide use.

Are there any risks or benefits to you or your student to participate in the survey?

There are no reasonably foreseeable risks to you or your student arising from taking the survey. Data from this tool will help schools develop goals and plans that will benefit student's acquisition of knowledge, skills, and dispositions within ASD's Vision For Learning.
