Full disclosure: The Acellus courses you would take would be the same self-paced course whether you took the course through Wings to Soar or going directly to PowerHomeschool.org. Some people want their school course records all in one place and want our help with setting up the pacing and have the grade report on the term reports. We provide Office Hours support Monday-Friday 9-2 Central for many subjects. We have notes we can share for 20 of the courses. Wings to Soar does not have a team member who is able to provide support with many CTC and some electives at this time.

Just-Right Level Academic Assessments

If you'd like your child to enroll with Wings to Soar the next step is to <u>purchase the student Just-Right Level Academic Placement</u>

Assessments. Within 1-3 business days, our team will set your child up in the online academic placement assessments you requested.

Watch for an email with instructions and login information. These assessments will help us identify your child's skill gaps. We'll back down to their just-right level so they can be independently successful.

We lay out a plan to spread these assessments out over a week. Have your child do these assessments when they are fresh, alert, and able to give their best focus. Do NOT help, other than to encourage them to do their best. Your child is welcome to use the audio support provided. The assessments are adaptive. Your help will artificially move them into material that is too difficult.

2-Week Jump Start

When we send your child's academic assessment results, we'll invite you to sign up for our \$147 2-Week Jump Start. This will be a Path to Success Personalized Learning Plan for the independent parts of reading, language arts, and math skills created for your child based on:

- the information on your assessment request form
- the results of your child's assessment
- and any extra information you choose to share.
