Hosting Information

General Information

1. Please print this Document.
2. Print all three gate documents (SSSAD Website - Admin tab - Hosting Responsibilities icon (PW - SSSAD2021)):
 - a. Admissions Poster
 - b. QR Code - guides spectators to player rosters
 - c. Gate Reporting Form
3. Place a copy of the SSSAD Junior Rule on the score table - found at the bottom of this document.
4. Keep a copy of the scoresheet for each game hosted.

Gate

1. Each host school is responsible for collecting a gate which must be submitted to SSSAD (as per gate reporting protocol):
 - a. A gate must be set up a minimum of 30 minutes prior to each game hosted.
 - b. The gate may close immediately at the start of the third quarter of the last game hosted of the evening.
2. You will find the following on the SSSAD website - Admin tab - Hosting Responsibilities icon (PW - SSSAD2021):
 - a. Admission Posters
 - b. QR Code - Gives fans a direct link to the the rosters
 - c. Gate Reporting Form
 - d. Gate must be remitted to the SSSAD office using the forms found under the Gate Reporting Icon (PW - sssadgate)
 - i. Please see your athletic director for help with this, as we use the same process for senior basketball.
3. Gate daily admission prices:
 - i. \$5.00 for adults per day
 - ii. STUDENTS ARE FREE FOR THE 2026 JUNIOR BASKETBALL PLAYOFFS
 - iii. Please stamp all attendees with a 'SSSAD' stamp as they may be traveling from one venue to another. Please alert your gate staff to admit individuals with a stamp.

NOTE: Season Passes are not valid for SSSAD or SHSAA playoffs.
Staff ID and SSSAD event passes are valid for SSSAD playoffs.

Funds Allocated by SSSAD to Host School

1. Each school will receive a hosting grant once gate and tournament reporting forms have been submitted to SSSAD.
 - a. This grant will be dependent on the number of games hosted at your school.
2. Complete the SSSAD Gate Reporting Form (found on the SSSAD website) immediately following the last game you host.
3. **You may take \$25/game from this gate for the purpose of paying minor officials (same policy as Senior games):**
 - a. Please make note of this on the reporting form.
 - b. Please ensure your minor officials have been trained.

Assignment of Officials

1. Saskatoon Basketball Officials Association (SBOA) will assign officials for the year end tournaments.
2. SSSAD will be invoiced directly by SBOA.

Reporting of Scores

1. **Coaches must submit year end tournament scores using the TeamLinkt App immediately following each game.**
2. **Host schools must keep the score sheets for all games hosted.**

Awards

1. City Champions will receive gold medals and the league Championship trophy following the gold medal game..
2. Silver medals will be awarded to the runner up following the gold medal game.
3. Please arrange for the **Principal, Vice-Principal, or Athletic Director** to hand out the medals and trophy at the conclusion of the gold medal game.
4. SSSAD will ensure the trophies and medals are delivered to the host schools prior to the tournament.
5. Please return the left-over medals to the SSSAD office.
6. Please take a picture of the Gold medal winners and email Scott Aaro.
7. Thank the SSSAD Sponsors: TCU Financial - Pizza Hut - Saskatoon Coop.
8. Thank the SSSAD Partners: Summit Sports & Health - Prairie Flooring - Budget Rentals.
9. Have a PA system available to thank the sponsors and partners.
10. Introduce the medal presenters, announce the awards, and congratulate the teams.

Procedure

- Announcement for the teams to line up on volleyball attack lines.
- Announce SSSAD Sponsors and partners- see above.
- Announce award presenter(s).

- Congratulate both teams on a well played game and a great season.
- Present silver medals.
- Present gold medals.
- Present trophy.
- Take a picture of the winning team with the trophy and email Scott Aaro.

Spectator Conduct

1. Please communicate to gym supervisors the SSSAD expectations for spectator conduct. There should be a poster hanging in the gymnasium.
2. Please be aware of parents/supporters who are not familiar with SSSAD conduct expectations.

GREEN LEAGUES – Boys and Girls

- Player to player defense for the entire season.
- Player to player press permitted for the entire season.
- No zone defense or zone press permitted.
- No doubling teaming outside the 3-point line.
- When inbounding, 1 check faces the in-bounder, the other looks after their own.
- After a 20-point lead teams must play half court player to player.

ALL BLUE LEAGUES – Championship & Premiere

Pre - Christmas Break

- Player to player defense.
- Player to player press permitted.
- No zone defense or zone press permitted.
- No doubling teaming outside the 3-point line.
- When inbounding, 1 check faces the in-bounder, the other looks after their own.
- After a 20-point lead teams must play half court player to player.

Post Christmas Break

- Full FIBA Rules.
- After a 20-point lead teams must remove all presses.

OVERTIME – 3 MINUTES FOR ALL LEAGUES

Some of these modifications are difficult to enforce by experienced officials let alone by rookies or volunteer officials. COACHES MUST COMMUNICATE BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER THE GAME IF THERE ARE INTERPRETATION PROBLEMS.
