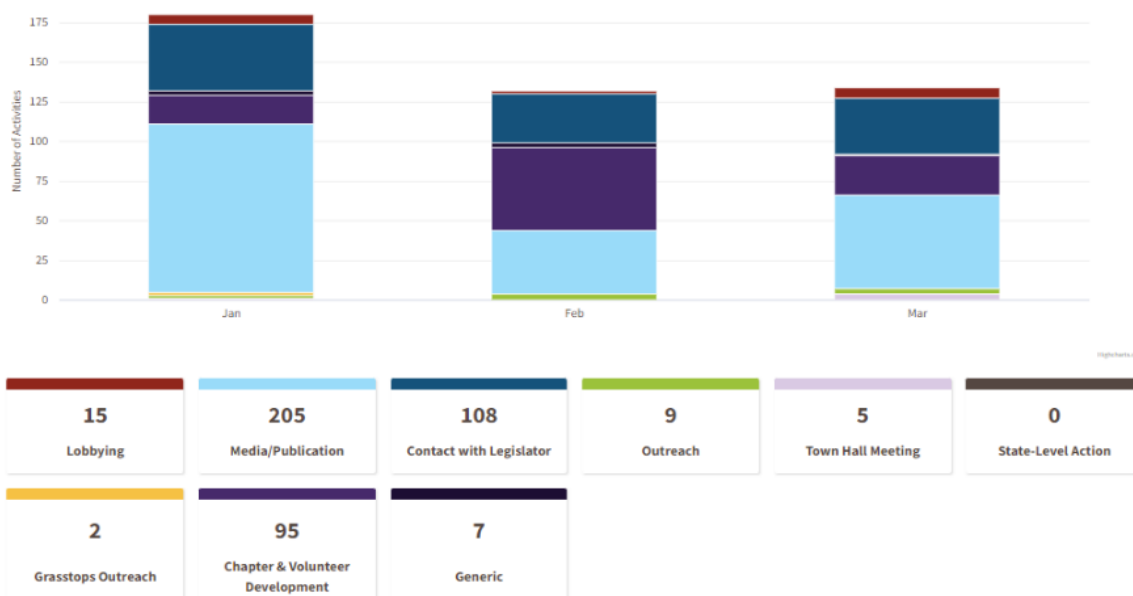

COVID precautions for in-person participants at our event in Ottawa

- Asking that you only attend if you are vaccinated
- Masks but they can be removed for drinking and eating and when social distancing in open spaces
- Please no walking while eating or drinking in our conference room
- Social distancing
- Sanitizing hands
- Keeping table mates the same both days
- We are capping numbers at 50 people for the in-person event
- You most likely will not be permitted to lobby your MPs on Parliament Hill in their offices due to their COVID restrictions currently in place

If lobbying your MP in person please follow COVID safety rules

In consultation with our volunteers, we are also currently exploring the deployment of rapid antigen tests at the in-person event too.

\$75 for the entire in person event

\$0 for the online

The cost of our conferences for the venue, food, AV, and photocopying generally run about \$300-\$400 per person. We keep registration fees low because our incredible volunteers come to Ottawa on their own time and dime. We also waive fees for students and low income volunteers. 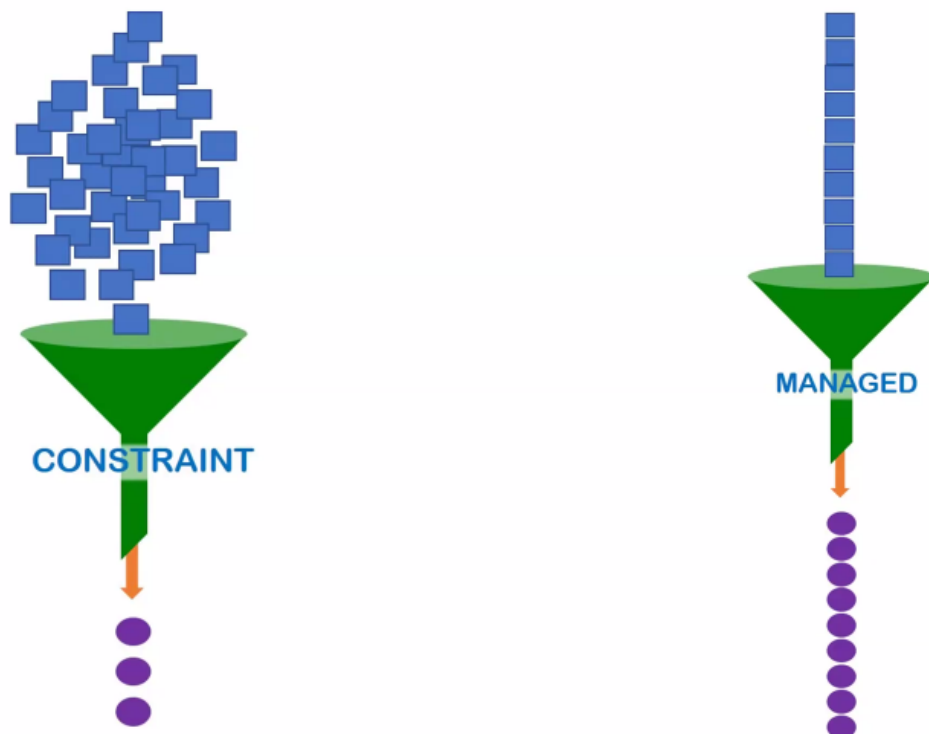
ACTION #2 We are lobbying together in May

Feel free to use the following scripts/outlines in your correspondence, edited as you see fit:

Phone Script Outline

- Introduce yourself as a constituent in *[insert name of electoral district]*
- Express authentic appreciation for something the politician has done lately.
- Introduce CCL Canada:
 - Non-partisan, volunteer-led, not-for-profit
 - Focussed on advocating for a Carbon Fee and Dividend policy — a policy which is non-partisan, effective, and economically efficient
 - Over 40 chapters, representing over 120 ridings in Canada
- On the week of May 2nd, CCL volunteers from across the country will be meeting with our Members of Parliament to hear their thoughts on current climate policy and carbon pricing in Canada, and to work on shared goals for tackling the climate crisis together
- We would like to schedule a meeting for sometime in May
