Consider the best way to pluralize bitcoin units in your product. Treatment of plurals can differ between languages and cultures. When choosing a pluralization scheme, consider what your users are likely to be accustomed to.

Typically, the word "bitcoin" can mean a singular or a plural. In the <u>early days of bitcoin</u>, it was common to see people use the word "bitcoins" as a plural. This has become a less commonly used word, though it's still grammatically correct. However, it's far more common to see the satoshi (sat) expressed as "satoshis" (sats) when plural.

Whatever pluralization scheme you choose, it's good to be consistent with this choice throughout your product.
