Almost twenty thousand students and young adults are packed into the Jiffy Lube Arena, about 20 minutes outside of Washington DC. The first musical act of the night, Lizzo, is finishing up and Bruce Springsteen is getting ready backstage. Before he does though, Democratic Party Chairman Zairn walks out onto the stage to loud cheers and chants.

"Hello and welcome Chesapeake, to our first Rock the Vote concert of the 2019 election! I hope everyone is having fun tonight, I won't be long but I want to remind you all why we're here. Other than to listen to have a great time tonight! This election is a one in a generation choice for us. The choices we make on election day could define the next 20 years. We have made important progress combating climate change, ending mass incarceration and watching over corporations. We've legalized Marijuana, increased funding to our schools, and begun to rebuild our crumbling roads and bridges."

"But the Republican party want to roll back all the progress we've made the last eight years. They will appoint conserveative judges who will roll back Abortion protections, and protect the wealthy. Climate change will continue to ravage our country, and guns will continue to haunt our schools and malls. We cannot let that happen!"

"If you want a free and fair America, if you want an America of equals, if you want Justice in America, you need to vote! Vote Democratic this November!"

The audience thunders their approval.
