Grace Ministry may be able to subsidize 50% of counseling sessions, up to ten sessions per church member. This subsidy is fluid and subject to change based on need and budget.

We recommend you start below with Philadelphia Renewal Network (PRN) as we have a contract with them for a reduced session fee of \$125.

If you feel PRN is not a good fit, we can consider subsidizing counseling fees with alternative providers at the same rate (50% of \$125= \$62.50). We ask that you pay out of pocket at time of session, and then provide us with your invoice. Invoices need to be submitted within 30 days of session date in order to be reimbursed.
