The Wood-Sawyer is very friendly to Lucie as she comes to stand outside the tower that holds Darnay. (pp. 318-319)	The Wood-Sawyer is spying for the Defarges.
Carton tells Lorry that if Lorry doesn't follow his instructions, many lives would be sacrificed. (p. 394)	Carton plans to sacrifice himself for Darnay and wants to make sure that the plan works, even when he's not present to carry it out.
Dr. Manette asks Darnay not to tell him Darnay's name until the wedding morning. (p. 156)	Darnay is part of the Evermonde family that imprisoned Dr. Manette.
Manette looks ill after Darnay tells the story of a prisoner who hid a letter in his cell. (p. 116)	Manette hid a letter while in prison that explains his imprisonment and denounces the Evermonde family.
Jacques Three and Defarge are among the people who storm the Bastille; they search 105 North Tower (p.248)	Monsieur Defarge says he found Dr. Manette's letter in the chimney of 105 North Tower.
