How To Sign Up For A Jam Slot

Three bands you know and love (**Strawberry Jealous**, **Mongomaniacs**, and **SuperBloom**) will be performing as the main acts. Bands will be doing dual duty – performing 5 of their songs together, and then acting as backing band for 5-10 karaoke songs.

Interested in playing with them? Here's what you do!

- Go to this signup form
- Select a **band** to perform with, and a **song** on the **instrument** of your choice
- You can choose more than one, but you'll probably only get one!

When signups close on Sat 4/26, we'll confer with the bands to pick the songs. If one of your songs is picked, we'll send you an email. You'll then reply with a receipt for a \$25+ donation to one of the organizations. You'll have a month to practice your song, and so will your backing bands!

Event Theme

Overall theme is "Fight for your Friends, Family, and Freedom". Goal is to build hope, optimism, and energy by connecting people around music. Vibe is upbeat, friendly, participatory – but also patriotic, determined, and forceful. America is about personal freedom, equality, and open doors. United together with our friends & families, we will prevail.

Political Fundraising

Goal of this Jam is to raise \$5K for various political activism groups.

No cover, but attendees will be asked to make a donation at the door. Suggested amount \$20. Honor system / donate-what-you-can, no static if folks don't make a donation.

We want a big party crowd, so attendance will be open to anyone. Bands will be encouraged to get their fans, friends, and family to attend.

Bands will help promote the fundraising efforts in two ways:

- When making their donation at the door, folks will be asked if they were invited by a specific band. ("No, I'm just here for the Jam" is an OK answer.) We will track which band brought in the most donations.
- Band karaoke slots will be auctioned off with donations. Suggested minimum donation is \$20 (on top of attendance), although folks will be encouraged to donate more if they can. To promote inclusiveness, the auction will not be done as a "bidding war". Instead each band will be expected to fill a minimum of 5 karaoke slots, but can have as many as 10 (or more)?
- Total number of donors will be tallied for each band. Winner will be announced at the end of the Jam. Award is having their awesomeness recognized in front of the crowd.

Political Education

Use the forum to help educate people – gently! – on a few important topics. Post information on the walls and/or have "one-pager" fliers available for people to read. Ask each band to make a short "hey, this is something that we think you should know about" talk as part of their set.

Possible topics:

- Signal and keeping your information safe
- Project 2025 / DOGE / Network State
- Limits on executive power
- Know your rights (if detained, or you see illegal police actions)

Sound / Event Planning

Equipment:

- Mixing handled by Music City. Jam Sound Techs are welcome to "help".
- equipment
 - Drum kit + bass amp provided by Music City.
 - Other amps + mics as per standard Jam.
 - Keyboard TBD.
- Karaoke players can bring their own instrument, or borrow the band's.
 - No swapping amps / pedals / mics.

Timeline (initial proposal, still tbd):

- Load-in: 5pm
- Bands start: 6pm
- Set length: 60 75 mins, plus 10 min switchover.
- Event ends: 10pm
- Loadout finished by 11pm

Karaoke details:

- Bands provide list of 10+ songs they are willing to play
 - People can request their own songs, but suggested donation in \$40+
 - o Bands can veto requests.
- People can request karaoke for any part: vocals, guitar, bass, keys, drums, etc.

- Open question should we have song signups in advance (as per jam0, on live-on-the-fly?
 - Option #1: Signups for karaoke spots are expected 2+ weeks in advance of event. Bands and people practice their songs beforehand.
 - Option #2: Bands are expected to be ready to cover any of their "songs they can play" on the fly.
- Only swap in 1-2 people per song.
- Nail down cover list 3+ weeks in advance. Bands are expected to practice & be tight.
- Make repeated announcements that we're performing "without a net", don't expect perfection.

Other:

- DJ spinning before, after, and between sets.
- Overall MC for event: zenkat
