Lesson Plan Sonia Delanay Tk

Materials Needed:

Tagboard
Pencils
Oil Pastels or Crayons
Various Round Lids

*Each child gets one piece of tagboard and pencil.

*Each table of 5 to 6 children gets a bunch of round lids and one tray of oil pastels or crayons.

Present Slideshow

Lesson:

Demonstrate how to trace round lids on paper to create circles. Make sure to show how the circles should overlap and that smaller circles can go inside larger ones to create concentric circles. Encourage the children to trace at least 7 circles onto their tagboard of various sizes. Once they have done the tracing of the lids in pencil they can then color in the overlapping circles with oil pastels or crayons.

If there is time at the end of the session, bring the children together to show their finished projects to the rest of the class.
