The GCP Planning Tool will be used to organize and plan for the implementation of a project to meet one or more of the Global Goals of the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

Which United Nations Sustainable Development Goal(s) are you aiming to implement at school or **push** out into the community? Dig into the targets and indicators and look for issues that have one degree of separation between you and your community. Make it personal to your community of students.

Brainstorm and gather information about how your chosen local issue is related to the SDG. Take a critical look at the issue and gather the required information to guide further decision making.

What would your community look like if this goal were achieved? What kinds of actions would have to occur? Who would have to be involved to make it happen? Think about your local environment – what are the issues affecting it?

After picking one idea to focus on, use this Planning Tool to lay out a path to action.
