Below, you'll find important information for upcoming camping trip at Milton Basecamp

Saturday:

10:00 - 11:00 AM - Arrival

- Look for some familiar faces or cars but you can park pretty much anywhere in the lot. [See map.](#)
- At this time, non-scouts can head over to the main desk at the Egan Center to purchase adventure wristbands. Please refer to the map for the location.
- Hike into camp. Follow signs for the James E West and Pumpkin. We also get Lean-tos #10 which can be used by a group of scouts. (Note we do not have Lean-tos #11) Please see [camp site map here](#)
- Grab a kart if needed, they are in the parking lot.
- Set up Camp and get established (there is drinking water near camp)
- **Wristbands!** Pack 722 will hand out Scout Wristbands, look for Andrew. If you arrive after 11am, there will be clipboard with names and wristbands left out (*Reminder, non scouts will need to walk down to the Egan center to purchase wristbands*)

11:00 AM - 5:00 PM - Venture Programs

- Scouts and families explore the venture programs walking from station to station. This is self guided. See example below.
- **Note** *it's first come first serve, so some areas are more popular and wait times may be long. Encourage the scouts to prioritize and be aware wait times may be longer than expected depending on the number of scouts attending this weekend.*

5:00 PM - Dinner

- Pack dinner is hotdogs. We will have them cooked and in water (ballpark style)
- Pack will provide buns, ketchup, mustard, and relish.
- If the above dog is not your style, you can cook it on a stick over the fire.
- Feel free to bring any special fun toppings and or sides if you like for your family.

6:30 PM Campfire

- Our closing campfire of the season with summer announcements.
- Cubmaster will perform the Ashes Ceremony.
- Skits, songs, stories, and instruments are encouraged. We love to see engagement from everyone!

Sunday:

7:00 - Breakfast. Pack will have a cold breakfast, muffins, bread, fruit ect... Look for Scott.
